

A few weeks ago, the Sisters in Jesus the Lord from Vladivostok, Russia, visited our parish. On the weekend of July 30/31, their pastor, Daniel Maurer, CJD, from Mary Mother of God Mission Society and the Vladivostok Mission will visit our parish to speak about the Roman Catholic Mission Churches in Eastern Russia.



Mary Mother of God

Reviving the Roman Catholic Church
in Eastern Russia

In the early 1900's, the Russian Far East boasted a thriving Roman Catholic population. Many Russians, Poles, Lithuanians, and other groups inhabited the area and had built schools, hospitals, and beautiful churches. After the revolution of 1917, Russia became an emblem of the Communist era, a land without churches and without God. Under Stalin, all Catholic churches were confiscated, and Dioceses closed. Most churches were desecrated or destroyed. Catholics were murdered by the hundreds of thousands and their bodies dumped into mass graves.

Two American priests, Fr. Myron Effing, CJD, and Fr. Daniel Maurer, CJD, arrived in Vladivostok in 1992 to help re-establish the Church in the region and provide charitable assistance to the many poor. Now that the foundations have been laid, additional priests and sisters are joining the work, and parishes are growing and multiplying, very slowly, but surely.



Position Summary: The Administrative Assistant will work in the areas of liturgy and administration assisting the Pastor and Business Manager with tasks related to those departments. The Administrative Assistant will also assist with reception duties providing information to all those who contact the Parish Office and will provide administrative and related office services to staff.



Accountabilities for Liturgy Include:

- Assists with purchasing and maintaining of candles, candle oil, wine, hosts, ashes, palms, altar linens, vestments for clergy and altar servers, and all supplies related to worship.
- Assists with maintaining liturgical minister roles in Ministry Scheduler online software, including ensuring ministers are scheduled to serve at various liturgical functions, adding new ministers to the software system, and communicating when ministers are needed to volunteer.

Accountabilities for Administration Include:

- Performs administrative and clerical support tasks to parish staff and visitors, as needed.
- Plans and carries out duties related to special events – staff lunches, retreats, and volunteer appreciation events.
- Greets parishioners, visitors, and guests; determines the purpose of each person’s visit and directs or escorts him or her to the appropriate location.
- Answers, screens, and directs phone calls to staff; responds to inquiries and takes messages.
- Responsible for entering new parishioner information into the parish database and related communication portals.

News from the Principal’s Desk

St. Martin de Porres Catholic School closed out the 2021-2022 academic year with great success! We navigated the murky waters of COVID, the flu, and various other viral illnesses while engaging our students in new learning experiences throughout the year. Last year our school had the greatest enrollment growth of any other school in the diocese, and we are on course for this same kind of growth this new year. After being in our new school building for only five years, we are now at the point where we have officially outgrown our facilities. This 2022-2023 school year, we will be using every classroom for a specific grade level. We will have two class sections for PreK-4 through 4th grade. We are relocating the school chapel to a smaller space so the chapel space can be used for the Learning Lab and After School Care. We will have floating teachers and shared space. We are starting the new year with the PreK-3, PreK-4 and Kindergarten classes full with wait lists. This is a first for SMdP!

You are probably thinking so what will we do to get more space? I foresee a building campaign in our future so that we can add on additional classrooms and other educational areas. This is an exciting time for our St. Martin de Porres school community, and I look forward to our continued growth and success!


