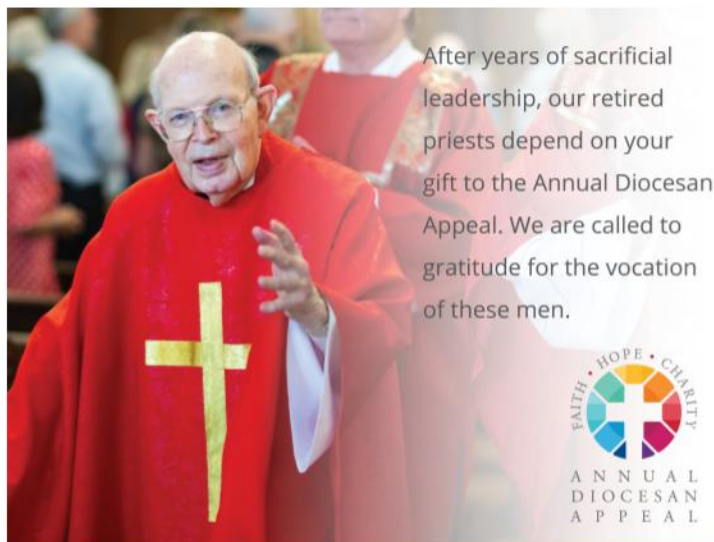
## Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

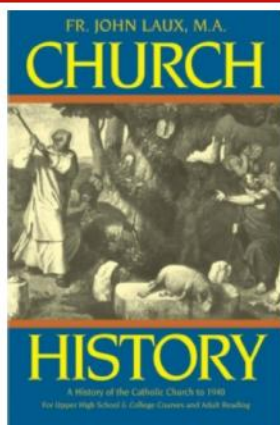
## Book of the Names of the Dead

## Helpful Mass Etiquette Reminders

### Fast before Mass.

It is Church law that we fast for at least 1 hour before receiving Holy Communion. Water and medicine can be consumed, of course. The purpose is to help us prepare to receive Jesus in the Eucharist.

### No Food, Drink, or Gum in Church.

Bringing a snack into church, even if for a small child, is not appropriate. We want to set the Church apart as a place of prayer and reflection. This applies to toys, too!

### Dress modestly and appropriately.

Wear your Sunday best! If you need to change clothes to do something else after Mass, you are on the right track! These should not be clothes which we would feel comfortable wearing just anywhere. It is okay that these clothes are different because what we are doing is different!

### Show up early.

If for some reason you cannot be on time, then try not to disturb others. Please do not present yourself for Holy Communion since you were not able to fully participate in the Mass due to your tardiness. Getting to Mass early allows you to pray and prepare yourself better for Mass.

### When we enter and leave Church, we genuflect toward the Tabernacle.

Christ is present for our sake. By allowing our right knee to hit the floor, we acknowledge He is our Lord. If someone is physically unable to genuflect, then a bow is sufficient.

### Please maintain reverence while in Church.

Once you enter the sanctuary – it is not the time or place to visit with those around you. A simple greeting to those around you is sufficient. After Mass at Coffee and Donuts is the place to catch up!

### Pray after Mass if you feel called to do so.

It is a good custom, though not required, to offer a prayer of thanksgiving after Mass is over. Mass is concluded after the final blessing when the deacon dismisses us, not after Holy Communion!
