
Retirement Fund for Religious December 10-11, 2022



In 1988, Catholic bishops of the United States launched the Retirement Fund for Religious to address the significant lack of retirement funding for Catholic sisters, brothers, and priests in religious orders.

For most of their lives, elder religious worked for little to no pay. There were no 401(k) plans or pensions. Religious

communities are financially responsible for the support and care of all members. Income, earnings, and expenses are managed separately from the parish and diocesan structures of the Catholic Church. The average annual Social Security benefit for a religious is \$7,326, whereas the average U.S. beneficiary receives \$19,896. The National Religious Retirement Office (NRRO) coordinates this annual appeal and distributes the proceeds to assist eligible U.S. religious communities with their retirement needs. Below, you will find a summary statement of income to the end of Quarter 1 of fiscal year 2023 which began on July 1, 2022 and runs through June 30, 2023. Comparing the 1st quarter of FY23 to the 1st quarter of FY22, our regular offertory collections are up by about 5%, however, we have seen a significant decrease in the number of one-time contributions. This, combined with the rising costs of goods and services is reflected in our current deficit position.
