





Below, you will find a summary statement of income to the end of Quarter 1 of fiscal year 2023 which began on July 1, 2022 and runs through June 30, 2023. Comparing the 1st quarter of FY23 to the 1st quarter of FY22, our regular offertory collections are up by about 5%, however, we have seen a significant decrease in the number of one-time contributions. This, combined with the rising costs of goods and services is reflected in our current deficit position.




