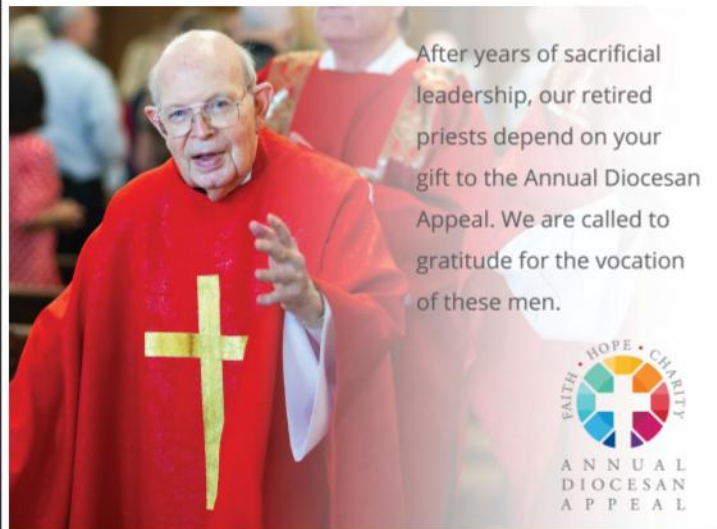

This, combined with the rising costs of goods and services is reflected in our current deficit position.

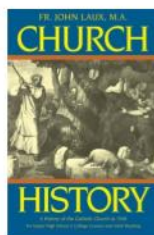
