We will have 2 categories: Children (up to 17 years old), and Adult (18 and older).


What can I submit as a design: An original picture or design that is related to Saint Martin de Porres in works/deeds, faith, culture. It must be a single-color design.



April 27: The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple


May 4: The Meeting Jesus on His Way to Cavalry

Each Holy Hour will start with the Lady of Seven Sorrows rosary and include meditative reflections throughout the hour. Please join us!










