



St. Martin de Porres Catholic School

The St. Martin de Porres Catholic School Advisory Council (SAC) has two openings on its board for the 2023-2024 academic year. One opening is for a parishioner and the other opening is for a current school parent. A perspective parishioner candidate must be an active parishioner who is in good standing with the church and who does not have a child or grandchild in the school. The School Advisory Council's role is to advise the principal and pastor on policies and decisions which affect the life of the parish school. A council member serves a three-year term. The Advisory Council meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. Advisory Council members also sit on one of five different committees which, in turn, meet at different times throughout the course of the year, depending upon the tasks at hand. Discernment for this position will take place on Sunday, August 27th, at 1:00 p.m. in the Parish Chapel.
