Neighbors Nourishing Neighbors (N3) is a no-boundary food pantry in Prosper, TX, combating food insecurity in North Texas. As a partner agency of the North Texas Food Bank (NTFB), N3 serves residents across eleven counties. While NTFB refers more than 60% of those using the pantry, it fulfills only 40% of N3 requests. N3 relies on corporate partners like Costco, Kroger, and Walmart, along with private donations, to provide essential food items. With community support, like that from St. Martin de Porres, N3 strives to bridge the gap and create a resilient, food-secure future where no neighbor goes hungry.



July 9th. Because this monstrance belonged to St. John Paul II when he was the Holy Father and he gifted it to the USCCB (who then entrusted the monstrance to Serra International for use in support of praying for vocations), this monstrance is a Second Class Relic since he is now a Holy Saint. Please plan to attend Eucharistic Adoration to see this monstrance, pray for vocations and spend some quality time with our Lord and Savior!

#### Peru Mission Support Group

Did you know SMdP has a Sister Parish in Peru? The Sanctuary of the Sacred Heart of Jesus - Surco, or in Spanish, Santuario Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. 




