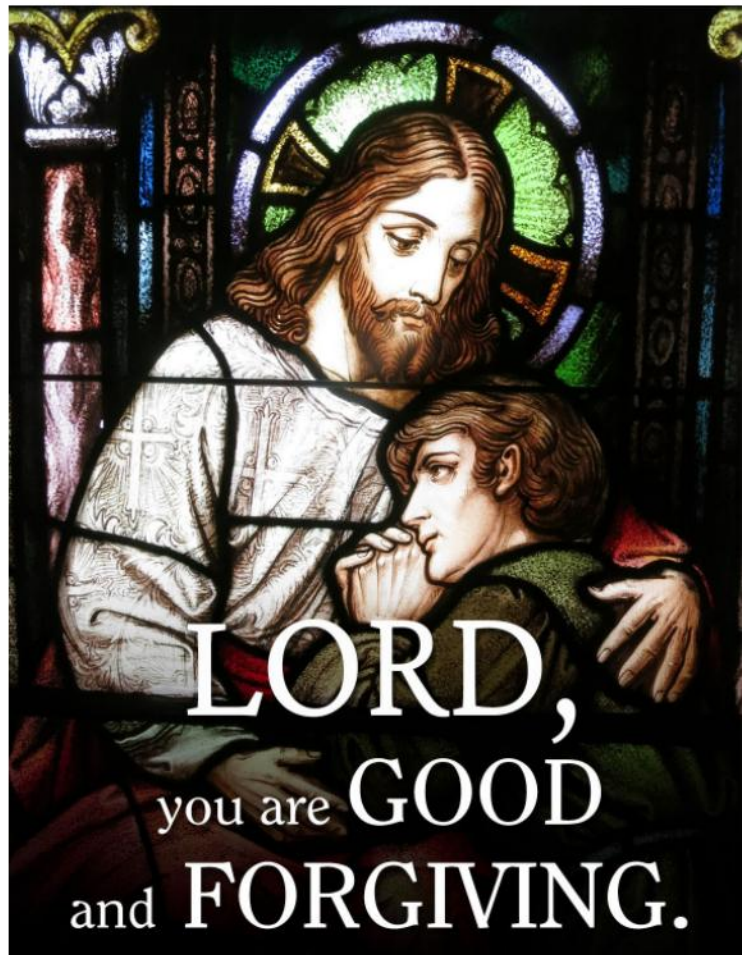



St. Martin de Porres Catholic School

The St. Martin de Porres Catholic School Advisory Council (SAC) has two openings on its board for the 2023-2024 academic year. One opening is for a parishioner and the other opening is for a current school parent. A perspective parishioner candidate must be an active parishioner who is in good standing with the church and who does not have a child or grandchild in the school. The School Advisory Council's role is to advise the principal and pastor on policies and decisions which affect the life of the parish school. A council member serves a three-year term. The Advisory Council meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. Advisory Council members also sit on one of five different committees which, in turn, meet at different times throughout the course of the year, depending upon the tasks at hand. Discernment for this position will take place on Sunday, August 27th, at 1:00 p.m. in the Parish Chapel. Interested candidates should stop by the School Office to pick up a SAC New Board Member Questionnaire. This questionnaire should be returned to the School Office or emailed no later than August 24 to the principal, Mrs. Flanagan, at: sflanagan@smdpcatholic.org.

The Loreto House mission

Frequently asked questions

What is unique about Loreto House?

Loreto House is the only Catholic Pregnancy Resource, Parenting, Medical Clinic in the Diocese of Fort Worth. As an official apostolate of the Diocese of Fort Worth, all services are in alignment with our Catholic faith. Loreto House does not perform or refer our patients/guests for abortion services. Our advocates emulate our Blessed Mother in serving our guests. What would Mary do?

Does Loreto House serve non-Catholics?

Yes, we provide services to any person regardless of faith, or no faith, and we do not proselytize our guests. If a guest does not want to receive faith services, she still receives the full level of our other services. We do not proselytize or pressure our guests.

Abortion is not legal in Texas, why do we need a pro-life organization like Loreto House?

Unfortunately, there are many people who assume that now abortion is not legal in Texas, the pro-life cause has ended. After the Supreme Court decision, we had a noticeable increase in the number of women seeking our assistance. Additionally, more abortion-minded women come to us to learn about alternatives to abortion and options that do not involve the taking of human life. For many years we have heard the pro-abortion community claims that pro-lifers only care about the baby and do nothing for the mother. This is false, as Loreto House “walks with moms” during their pregnancy and up to 36 months after the birth. Our educational program features over one hundred up to date courses on a variety of pregnancy and parenting topics. A typical Loreto House mom can receive our assistance for years.

What is the experience at Loreto House for our guests?

When a woman is worried about an unexpected pregnancy, she often feels like she is living within a tornado and there is a loss of hope. She may be a teen or a college student and suddenly her world seems hopeless. She may experience coercion to choose abortion from the father of the baby, parents, or friends. She is fearful as she enters our facility but suddenly, she realizes that Loreto House is different. All women receive hospitality and will meet an advocate who listens and offers real options that will allow her to welcome this child without fear. We often witness her tears of fear turn to tears of joy!

Why is Loreto House expanding its services to include medical?

Loreto House is answering the urgent need for prenatal care by expanding the medical department to full-clinic status. This was a landmark decision for our mission that required bringing in a P.A., two Nurse/Sonographers, a Medical Assistant, and two doctors. The leading cause of maternal death and illness in Texas is the lack of access to health care according to a recent report. We are on the front line in recognizing and treating prenatal conditions that are life threatening. This is a bold initiative that will require additional funding, but we realize that Loreto House is a logical organization to meet this need. We ask ourselves, “If we do nothing, who will step up to help provide access to health care that will create a better pregnancy and birth outcome for our guests?”

Are there volunteer opportunities?

Yes, it takes many volunteers and staff to provide the extensive amount of material goods we distribute to guests. We encourage church groups of any denomination, youth groups, and others to contact our Center Managers to learn about volunteer opportunities. We typically will distribute over 15,000 diapers per month as well as clothing, baby items, formula, wipes, car seats, food, and much more.

How can I help Loreto House?

First, please pray for the women we serve, the staff, and volunteers who help in our daily operations. Second, please become a financial partner to support the mission. Our Denton center provided over 8,000 one-on-one sessions with women in 2022 and the Flower Mound Center is already scheduling over twenty appointments per day. We anticipate that within 12 months, our two facilities will experience about 20,000 sessions annually. This requires our donor base be expanded to meet the needs of the mission.
