

St. Martin de Porres Catholic School is seeking part-time After School Care Workers for the 2023-24 school year. The hours are 3:15–6:15 daily while school is in session. Desired applicants will model the teachings of the Church, by providing a safe and engaging environment, and being able to manage students in an appropriate way. Minimum qualifications are a high school diploma or its equivalent. The position is a 10-month, non-exempt position. The St. Martin de Porres Catholic School Advisory Council (SAC) has two openings on its board for the 2023-24 academic year. One opening is for a parishioner and the other opening is for a current school parent. A perspective parishioner candidate must be an active parishioner who is in good standing with the church and who does not have a child or grandchild in the school. The School Advisory Council's role is to advise the principal and pastor on policies and decisions which affect the life of the parish school. A council member serves a three-year term. The Advisory Council meets on the third Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. Advisory Council members also sit on one of five different committees which, in turn, meet at different times throughout the course of the year, depending upon the tasks at hand. Discernment for this position will take place on Sunday, August 27th, at 1:00 p.m. in the Parish Chapel. Interested candidates should stop by the School Office to pick up a SAC New Board Member Questionnaire. 
