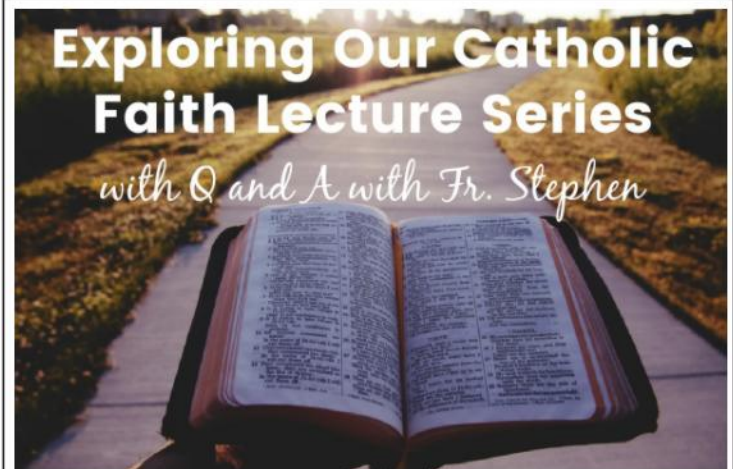


## St. Martin de Porres Catholic School

Minimum qualifications are a high school diploma or its equivalent. The position is a 10-month, non-exempt position.
