Dear Parents.

As we begin our academic year this week, I wanted to take this opportunity to thank you for entrusting your children's education to the Catholic schools of the Diocese of Fort Worth. The mission of a Catholic education is to teach as Jesus Christ taught, thus the mission of Catholic education calls on everyone, pastors, principals, teachers, students, and fathers and mothers to sacrifice with love that our children might grow in wisdom and knowledge and that our families might be strengthened.

Saint John Vianney once wrote, "The eyes of the world see no further than this life, as mine see no further than this wall when the door is closed. The eyes of the Christian see deep into eternity." St. Martin de Porres Catholic School

Well, the 2023-2024 academic year began quite smoothly last week with a record setting enrollment of 347 students in grades PK-3 through 8th grade. When we came back from our COVID hiatus back in 2021, we had 159 students, so we have more than doubled enrollment in last two years. We currently have three grade levels with waitlists and three other grade levels remarkably close to full with only a few open spots. Currently, we are the fastest growing Catholic school in the Diocese of Fort Worth.

This unprecedented growth has led us to a wonderful crossroads. This fall we will begin construction on eight new classrooms and a full-size gymnasium. We have outgrown our current building after only seven years, which is why there are now portable classrooms next to the Parish Hall awaiting utilities. These four classrooms will house our 6th, 7th, and 8th grade classes, as well as our middle school religion classes. Right now, we are using different areas in the school and Parish Hall for temporary classroom space.

This growth clearly shows that our North Texas Catholic families with elementary school age children desire a quality, Catholic education for their children, and as you know, nothing in life is free. Construction of the eight new classrooms and gym, as well as outfitting each space with the necessary furniture and accessories, comes with a hefty price tag. 




School Employment Opportunities





Year To Date

Financial Notes

Below, you will find a summary statement of income to the end of fiscal year 2023 which began on July 1, 2022, and ran through June 30, 2023. While we have seen an increase in our regular offertory collections, we have seen a decrease in the number of one-time contributions, however, our overall revenue was relatively static year over year.

On the expense side, we had an increase in payroll and benefit expenses due to adding staff to keep up with our continued growth, as well as incurring additional costs for benefits. This was offset, in part, by reducing some of our operating expenses through prudence, however, our overall picture is a deficit.

As mentioned, we have seen significant growth in our parish, but we are also experiencing our highest demand for families desiring a Catholic education for their children. Our school's current student population is 347 students, up from last year's end number of 289, an increase of 58 students. This growth has necessitated additional space, so we will be utilizing temporary buildings to accommodate. We have had plans drawn up for a new wing to be added to the school, which will bring the school to its full completion and will include a full-sized gym. Construction should begin in the next few months. The cost of this project will be paid for by the sale of the western 12 acres of our property.

As our growth continues, so does our need for space. To facilitate this, we will be starting a capital campaign in the near future. More details will be coming soon, so please be on the lookout for those.

We are very grateful for your continued support, and we encourage you to prayerfully consider your tithing amount. As we continue to grow, our parish has a real need. You can help!
