Welcome, Mr. Blake Thompson!

Mr. Blake Ryan Thompson has been a seminarian for the Catholic Diocese of Fort Worth since 2017. He was born and raised in Fort Worth, Texas. He converted to the Catholic faith in 2015 at Saint Jude Catholic Church in Mansfield, Texas. From 2017-2021, he studied Philosophy and the Liberal Arts



(BA) at Saint Joseph Seminary College in Covington, Louisiana, and from 2021-2023 dually Sacred Theology (STB) and Divinity (MDiv) at The Catholic University of America in Washington, DC. He will return to Washington DC in the fall of 2024 to complete his work on his STB and begin work on a Licentiate in Sacramental Theology (STL). He is on track to be ordained a Deacon in 2025 and a Priest in 2026.

Mr. Thompson served at Our Lady of Lourdes in Mineral Wells, Saint Francis of Assisi in Graford, Sacred Heart in Seymour, and Saint Mary in Megargel in 2017-2018. In 2018, Mr. Thompson, in conjunction with the Writing Center of Saint Joseph Seminary College, established the Saint Joseph Review and taught Sacred Theology to middle school students in the Archdiocese of New Orleans, Louisiana. He served at Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton in Keller in 2019. That same year, he was named Editor-in-Chief of the Saint Joseph Review and assumed responsibility for the college Writing Center where he assisted in seminarian learning accommodations and student publications. In 2020, Mr. Thompson worked in the Diocese of Fort Worth's Office of Property Management and Construction, and in 2021 Diocesan Spanish Ministries. From 2021-2022, Mr. Thompson served the urban poor operating the St. Martin of Tours Clothing Bank in Washington, DC, and from 2022-23 was assigned to Saint Mary's Church in Rockville, Maryland.

Mr. Thompson has been a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 7736 since 2017 and the Capital Norwegian Society and Sons of Norway Fraternity since 2021. Over the past year, he has been participating in research with the University of Bergen regarding medieval liturgical practices in Northern Europe. In his free time, Mr. Thompson enjoys cooking, listening to jazz, fishing, playing golf, and is an avid reader. He plays the trumpet and is a trained baritone singer, and remains an avid supporter of music and the arts in Fort Worth.

Mr. Thompson was assigned to St. Martin de Porres to complete his Pastoral Year, which is parish-based experience lasting approximately nine months. Be sure to say hello when you see him in our parish and community!

Financial Notes

Below, you will find a summary statement of income to the end of fiscal year 2023 which began on July 1, 2022, and ran through June 30, 2023. While we have seen an increase in our regular offertory collections, we have seen a decrease in the number of one-time contributions, however, our overall revenue was relatively static year over year.

On the expense side, we had an increase in payroll and benefit expenses due to adding staff to keep up with our continued growth, as well as incurring additional costs for benefits. This was offset, in part, by reducing some of our operating expenses through prudence, however, our overall picture is a deficit.

As mentioned, we have seen significant growth in our parish, but we are also experiencing our highest demand for families desiring a Catholic education for their children. Our school's current student population is 347 students, up from last year's end number of 289, an increase of 58 students. This growth has necessitated additional space, so we will be utilizing temporary buildings to accommodate. We have had plans drawn up for a new wing to be added to the school, which will bring the school to its full completion and will include a full-sized gym. Construction should begin in the next few months. The cost of this project will be paid for by the sale of the western 12 acres of our property.

As our growth continues, so does our need for space. To facilitate this, we will be starting a capital campaign in the near future. More details will be coming soon, so please be on the lookout for those.

We are very grateful for your continued support, and we encourage you to prayerfully consider your tithing amount. As we continue to grow, our parish has a real need. You can help! 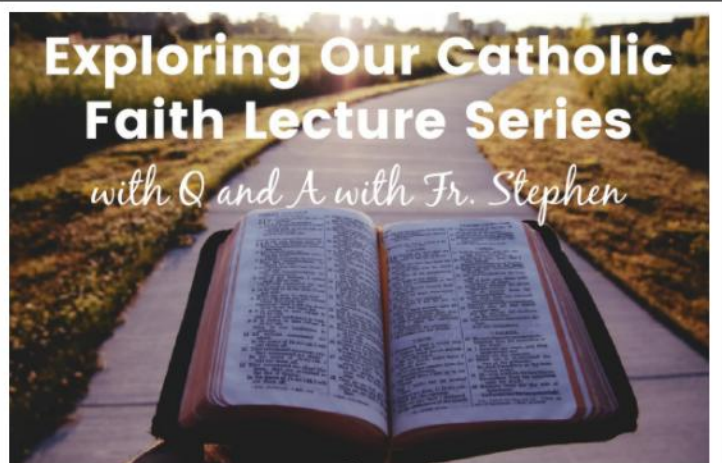
