6 FACTS ABOUT Saint Martin de Porres

On Nov. 3, the Catholic Church celebrates the feast of St. Martin de Porres, a Peruvian Dominican brother who lived a life of humble service and charity and became the first black saint of the Americas.



At a young age, Martin's father abandoned him, his mother, and his younger sister, leaving Martin to grow up in deep poverty.

A una temprana edad, el padre de Martín lo abandonó a él, a su madre y a su hermana menor, dejando a Martín crecer en pobreza extrema.



Being raised in poverty, Martin became an apprentice to barber-surgeon Marcel de Rivero at age 12.

Criado en la pobreza, Martín se convirtió en aprendiz del barbero cirujano Marcel de Rivero a los 12 años.



Martin was mocked and ridiculed all his life for being of mixed race. *Martin fue objeto de burla y ridiculez toda su vida por ser mulato*.



He was a pet lover and a vegetarian.

Era vegetariano y amante de mascotas.



He was known to levitate, bilocate (be two places at the same time), and cure the sick instantaneously.

Era conocido por levitar, bilocar (estar en lugares diferentes al mismo tiempo) y curar a los enfermos instantáneamente.



He distributed food and alms to the poor and needy in Lima and was friends with Saint Rose of Lima.

Distribuía alimentos y limosnas a los pobres y necesitados de Lima y era amigo de Santa Rosa de Lima.
