



Office of Religious Education | Becoming Catholic | June 14–15, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Blessed Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. As we celebrate the mystery of God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, we are reminded of the Church's ongoing mission to invite all people into communion with the Triune God through Jesus Christ. One of the primary ways this mission is fulfilled is through the *Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)*.

Formerly known as the *RCIA*, the *OCIA* is the normative process by which adults are gradually introduced to the Catholic faith and sacramental life. This journey of conversion is rooted in Sacred Scripture, illuminated by the Catechism of the Catholic Church, and supported by prayer, liturgy, and the witness of the Christian community. It echoes the ancient catechumenate of the early Church (cf. *OCIA*, nos. 1–5). This process is intended for:

- **Unbaptized adults**, who seek the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist.
- **Baptized non-Catholic Christians**, who desire full communion with the Catholic Church through a profession of faith, Confirmation, and the Eucharist.
- **Baptized Catholics** who have not yet received First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation and wish to complete their initiation.

OCIA Adapted for Children and Adolescents

In fidelity to *OCIA*, Part II:2, our parish also offers an adapted process for children and youth of catechetical age (age 7 and older), which provides age-appropriate formation and preparation for the sacraments. This includes:

- **Unbaptized children and adolescents** preparing to receive Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.
- **Baptized but uncatechized youth**, in middle or high school, who have not received First Communion and/or Confirmation, and who seek to deepen their formation in the Catholic faith.

As the Catechism teaches: “The sacraments of Christian initiation lay the foundations of every Christian life... they confer the graces needed for salvation” (*CCC*, no. 1212).

We kindly ask that all families participating in *OCIA Adapted* be registered and actively engaged in the life of **St. Martin de Porres Parish**. As the Catechism affirms, “*Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children in the faith*” (*CCC*, no. 2223). Your active participation is essential to the spiritual growth of your children and to the life of the Church.






