



"Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions." (Luke 12:15)

In a culture that often equates happiness with material wealth, Jesus offers a radical message: true joy is not found in what we own, but in how we give. Love, mercy, forgiveness - these invisible gifts are what truly enrich our lives. As Christian stewards, we are called not to hoard, but to share; not to grasp, but to give. Living a grateful and generous life shifts our focus from self-centeredness to God-centeredness.

That same spirit of generosity is at the heart of our Capital Campaign: ***His Church. Our Faith. Our Time.***

Week 1: Introducing Our Campaign

- **His Church:** We are embarking on a \$10 million campaign to support the next phase of God's vision for St. Martin de Porres.
- **Our Growth:** Since 2018, our parish has grown from 800 households to over 2,400—an extraordinary blessing!
- **Our Challenge:** Our current facilities can no longer fully support our expanding ministries and vibrant faith community.

Having completed **Phase One** of our expansion - the extension of the school and our new gymnasium, which many of you toured last weekend - we are now able to focus our efforts on the needs of the **parish**. This next phase includes:

- **Expanded Parking and Improved Accessibility** – \$1 million
- **Permanent Parish Offices and Meeting Spaces** – \$4.5 million
- **A Community Outreach Center and Storage Facilities** – \$4.5 million



With great joy and hope for the future, I invite you to participate in our parish's capital campaign:

His Church. Our Faith. Our Time.

God has richly blessed St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church and School. In just ten years, we have grown from 600 to 2,400 registered families, and we now welcome more than 2,000 people to Sunday Mass. Our school is thriving, our ministries are vibrant, and the faith of this community continues to deepen and flourish.

Yet with this growth comes the need for space — space to worship, to gather, to learn, and to serve. Having completed Phase 1 of our expansion – the extension of our school - we are now launching Phase 2 of our campus development: a \$10 million campaign to meet the immediate needs of our growing community and lay the groundwork for our future permanent church.

This phase includes:

- **Expanded Parking and Improved Accessibility** (\$1 million)
- **Permanent Parish Offices and Meeting Spaces** (\$4.5 million)
- **A Community Outreach Center and Storage Facilities** (\$4.5 million)

These developments are more than bricks and mortar. They are about mission — about making space for more families to find Christ, for our youth to grow in faith, and for the love of God to reach those in need.

We need your help to make this vision a reality. That's why I am asking you to prayerfully consider a sacrificial gift to this campaign. Every contribution, no matter the size, brings us closer to making this vision a reality.

In the weeks ahead, we'll be sharing more details about our plans and addressing any questions you may have. Our parish wide Commitment Weekend will take place September 6–7.

With thanks to almighty God, our community has come a long way in the past ten years. Let us come together now and build on the foundation of the last decade and move forward with these capital projects that will serve us for generations to come.
