This Weekend


Our beautiful parish campus - home to our parish hall and school - was made possible through the generosity of many, and a significant investment from the Diocese of Fort Worth. As a result, our parish and school currently carry a debt of approximately **\$40 million**.

In the spirit of stewardship and responsibility, we have instituted a **monthly second collection on the third Sunday of each month** to help reduce this debt. These funds will go directly toward fulfilling our financial obligations to the Diocese, which is a necessary part of our long-term vision for continued campus growth.

Debt repayment does not impact our plans for future building. Rather, it is a sign of our commitment to good stewardship and responsible planning, laying the groundwork for what comes next.

Stewardship Corner

In today's second reading, the author of the Letter to the Hebrews compares the Christian life to a long-distance race - requiring endurance, perseverance, and an unwavering focus on Jesus at the finish line. Good stewards are committed to running with purpose. They do not grow weary or lose heart, knowing that the joy awaiting them in Christ far outweighs the challenges along the way.

In the Gospel, Jesus reminds us that following Him will not always bring peace but may even cause division - especially when we stand firmly for the truth of the Gospel. The call of discipleship is not about comfort or popularity; it is about conviction. We are to keep our eyes fixed on Christ, stand strong in our faith, and speak the truth in love, even when it is difficult.

Our patron, **Saint Martin de Porres**, lived this kind of steadfast faith. Born in Lima, Peru, in 1579, the son of a Spanish nobleman and a freed slave from Panama, Martin faced prejudice and hardship throughout his life. Yet he responded not with bitterness, but with extraordinary humility, compassion, and perseverance. Known for his tireless care of the sick, his service to the poor, and his ability to unite people of different backgrounds, Saint Martin ran his race with his eyes fixed on Christ, no matter the obstacles.

Our parish's capital campaign, **His Church. Our Faith. Our Time**, strives to reflect his legacy.



God has richly blessed St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church and School. In just ten years, we have grown from 600 to 2,400 registered families, and we now welcome more than 2,000 people to Sunday Mass. Our school is thriving, our ministries are vibrant, and the faith of this community continues to deepen and flourish.

Yet with this growth comes the need for space — space to worship, to gather, to learn, and to serve. - + Familiarity with Microsoft Teams and Outlook will be a big plus for managing communications and schedules.





