Stewardship Corner

“For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.” – John 3:16

At the heart of our Catholic faith is the kerygma - the first proclamation of the Gospel. God created us to be in relationship with Him, yet sin broke that bond. Out of love, Jesus came into the world so that we might be reconciled to God. By following His example of sacrificial love, we receive the gift of joy in this life and the promise of eternal life in Heaven.

As stewards of these gifts, we are called to reflect Christ’s sacrificial love in our daily lives. One way we do this is through our parish’s capital campaign, **His Church. Our Faith. Our Time**. This weekend marks our second Commitment Weekend. Last week, Fr. Stephen reminded us of the sacrificial nature of this effort - a pledge over three years that each of us is asked to prayerfully discern. These pledges will fund much-needed improvements for our parish: expanded parking, new parish offices and meeting space, and a new outreach building with onsite storage.

At the same time, we are mindful of our responsibility to be good stewards of the resources entrusted to us. Next weekend, we will hold our monthly second collection for debt reduction. Alongside building for the future, we must also make a faithful effort to begin reducing the \$40 million we currently owe to the Diocese.


May we, as a parish family, unite in gratitude, sacrifice, and faith, trusting that God will bless and multiply our efforts for His glory.





