



Stewardship Corner

“No servant can serve two masters. He will hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon (wealth).” – Luke 16:13

In today’s Gospel, Jesus reminds us that money can easily compete with God for first place in our lives. When wealth becomes our master, it holds us captive; when we give, we place our trust back in the Lord. Generosity—whether through the offertory, parish ministry, or charitable works—frees us from clinging to money and teaches us to rely more deeply in the Lord’s providence.

As a parish family, one of the concrete ways we are called to live this trust is in addressing our parish debt. Many parishioners may not know the full history, so here is a snapshot:

- The land for our campus in Prosper was purchased for approximately **\$10 million**.
- The **construction of our parish hall and school in 2017** cost about **\$20 million**, covered largely by the Diocese.
- Over time, we’ve accrued about **\$6.5 million** in interest and additional expenses from the school extension.
- While other financial events have occurred - operating loans, the sale of land to Cook Children’s Hospital, and a prior capital campaign—the bottom line is this: **we currently owe the Diocese about \$40 million**.

Facing this reality can feel daunting, but it is also an invitation to put Jesus’ words into practice. By giving, we declare that money does not control us—we serve God first. Your gifts to the monthly **Debt Reduction Collection** directly help us live out this call to trust. And through your generosity, our capital campaign - **His Church. Our Faith. Our Time.** - is making real progress. Please continue to pray about your pledge; next week we look forward to sharing an update on the fruits of campaign.

Together, with faith guiding us and generosity freeing us, we can face our challenges and build a strong future for our parish.

Faith Formation and Sacraments

The Religious Education Office (REO) at our parish exists to share in the Church's Mission of forming disciples of Jesus Christ and handing on the deposit of faith entrusted to her by the Apostles. Rooted in Sacred Scripture, nourished by the Sacraments, and guided by the Magisterium, the REO seeks to accompany the faithful of every age in growing in the fullness of the Catholic faith: deepening knowledge of the truth, cultivating a life of prayer, participating in the liturgy and community life, and growing in love of God and neighbor. From the youngest children brought to the waters of Baptism, to those learning the story of salvation and preparing for their first encounter with Christ in the Holy Eucharist, to adolescents strengthened by the gifts of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation and youth ministry, our programs provide authentic catechesis and formation.

For adults, we offer opportunities to mature in faith through study, prayer, service, and communal life. We also welcome unbaptized adults, baptized non-Catholic Christians, and those who have been away from the practice of the faith through the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) and its adaptation for children and adolescents. In addition, ongoing adult faith formation supports parents, married couples, and single young adults in their vocation and witness.

These are not merely instructional sessions, but real opportunities to encounter the living Christ and His Body, the Church. Through them, we seek to build communion, discern and foster the gifts of the Holy Spirit, and nurture a lifelong vocation to holiness in full communion with Christ and His Catholic Church.




