





## Stewardship Corner

*“Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?” – Luke 17:18*

Most of us live relatively comfortable lives - we have food, shelter, clothing, and the means to enjoy life's blessings. Yet how often do we pause to give thanks? Those with the least often show the greatest gratitude. True stewardship begins with a thankful heart - one that recognizes everything we have is a gift from God and responds by sharing those gifts in return. Each day, take a moment to thank God for His generosity and reflect on how He is calling you to share your blessings in service to others.

As a parish, we also give thanks for the generous support shown to our ***His Church. Our Faith. Our Time.*** capital campaign. To date, we have received **\$1,842,523.14 in pledges** and **\$776,094.70 in cash collected** from **188 donors**, representing a **7.2% participation rate**. We are currently working with engineers on the parking lot design and anticipate beginning construction early next year.

There is still much work to do - we must raise an additional \$8 million to build the infrastructure our growing parish needs before we can begin our church. Please prayerfully consider making your pledge or increasing your current one and join us in gratitude and faith as we continue to build for the future of St. Martin de Porres.
