



Stewardship Corner

“...proclaim the word, be persistent whether it is convenient or inconvenient...” - 2 Timothy 4:2

It is not always convenient to be a good steward, especially when the busyness of our daily lives and the pull of our material world compete for our time and attention. Add in our own pride and self-interest, and living a stewardship lifestyle can become downright uncomfortable. But God never promised us comfort. He promised us purpose. He calls each of us not to ease, but to faithfulness - to live as disciples who proclaim His word whether it is convenient or not.

This weekend we celebrate **World Mission Sunday**, a day set aside for Catholics everywhere to renew our commitment to the missionary nature of the Church. Every baptized person is called to mission - to bring Christ's light, compassion, and truth to the world, beginning in our own homes, workplaces, and communities. Some are called to go to distant lands, but all of us are called to be witnesses right where we are.

Here at St. Martin de Porres, our parish joyfully participates in the Church's mission through our connections with faith communities around the world - including those in **Africa, Russia, Peru, East Asia, and Mexico**. Through prayer, financial support, and the sharing of gifts, we help sustain missionaries who serve in places where the Church is young, struggling, or persecuted. These partnerships remind us that we belong to something much greater than ourselves: one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church that spans every nation and language.

As stewards of God's love, let us take this Sunday as a chance to renew our missionary hearts. Let us pray for those who serve on the front lines of faith in faraway places, and let us look for ways to be missionaries of hope and mercy right here at home - in our families, our parish, and our community. When we live the Gospel with conviction and joy, we truly proclaim the word, whether it is convenient or inconvenient, and we bring the face of Christ to a world that longs to see Him.






