



Stewardship Corner

"...for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

- Luke 18:14

Pride and ego are at the root of many of our sins. When we believe our time is too valuable to share, our talents are more important than others', or our financial resources give us special status, we begin to make those things "gods" before God. Pride is the opposite of humility. As stewards, we are called to remember that all we have and all we are is a gift from God.

When we recognize God as the true source of our blessings, gratitude naturally follows - and gratitude leads us to humility. A humble and grateful heart is one that seeks to serve, to give, and to celebrate the goodness of God in community.

This weekend, as we gather for our **Fall Festival and the Feast of St. Martin de Porres**, we have a beautiful opportunity to live that humility and gratitude in action. St. Martin, known for his deep compassion and service to all, reminds us that holiness is found in simple acts of love and generosity. May our celebration this weekend be filled with joy, fellowship, and thanksgiving for the many gifts God has entrusted to our parish family.

Capital Campaign Update:

Through your generosity, we have received **\$1,945,279 in pledges** from **210 donors**, representing about **8% of our 2,600 parish families** and **19% of our \$10 million campaign goal**. Thank you to all who have made a commitment to **His Church. Our Faith. Our Time**.

We are pleased to share that we have **contracted with our architect and engineering firm** to begin the **parking lot design**, an important first step toward expanding our campus and meeting the needs of our growing parish community. Please continue to pray for the success of our campaign and consider joining those who have already made their pledge of faith and support.



St. Martin de Porres - Patron of Our Parish Feast Day: November 3

St. Martin de Porres was born in Lima, Peru, in 1579 to a mixed-race couple. His father, a Spanish nobleman, abandoned the family when Martin was young but later returned to support his formal and religious education. Though he grew up in poverty, Martin gave generously to those even less fortunate.

As a youth, Martin became a talented apprentice barber — a trade that at the time included treating wounds and prescribing medicine, combining the work of barbers, surgeons, doctors, and pharmacists. Though this could have led to a prosperous career, Martin instead chose a life of humility and service to Christ. He entered the Dominican Order as a lay helper, the lowest position available, taking on the heaviest duties and cleaning toilets in exchange for food and lodging. Eventually, he professed vows and became a lay brother.

Even as a vowed brother, Martin continued to assist servants with their work and challenged racial prejudices within the monastery through quiet strength and compassion. Deeply devoted to Christ's suffering, he spent long hours in prayer and fasting, always reflecting his love of God through humble service. Martin cared for all of creation — healing the sick, feeding the hungry, and even tending to the animals, from horses in the stables to mice on the grounds. His charity knew no bounds: he raised funds for young girls' wedding dowries and helped found an orphanage and school for children of all social classes.

Continuing His Mission Today

Volunteers in Lima, at the Obra Social Casa de San Martín de Porres, continue Martin's legacy by providing daily meals for elderly in need, as well as medications and supplies. Members of the Peru Mission Group, in conjunction with the Knights from our parish, help their efforts with financial support and annual visits.

Following the example of St. Martin, members of the Peru Mission Group also provide financial support, prayers and annual visits to two parishes in Peru. We currently send monthly donations to help volunteers provide daily meals at Our Lady of Lourdes in Villa Libertad, and also to help children with anemia at Sacred Heart of Jesus in Carapongo.

The Peru Mission Support Ministry gathers for Holy Hour in the Adoration Chapel on the Thursday before the first Friday of each month, from 7-8 pm. All are welcome to join.


