

Financial Notes

Parish Financial Update – First Quarter (as of September 30, 2025)

Our parish continues to make progress compared to last year. For the **first quarter of the fiscal year**, total revenue was **\$454,391**, up **10%** from 2024. Offertory increased by **6.9%**, and contributions and grants were up more than **30%**, thanks to your generosity and engagement.


Expenses have been reduced by 7% through careful management of payroll and operating costs. However, the parish still faces a **year-to-date deficit of \$30,190**, even after these improvements. While Mass attendance has grown nearly **10%** over last year, offertory has not kept pace with that growth.

We are deeply grateful for everyone who supports St. Martin de Porres through prayer, service, and financial gifts. As our parish family grows, we rely on consistent giving to sustain our ministries, meet operating costs, and continue serving our community.




