

Stewardship Corner

“...giving thanks to the Father, who has made you fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light.” - Colossians 1:12

As we celebrate Christ the King, we are reminded that everything begins and ends with God’s immense love for us. He desires our true happiness — not the fleeting kind that comes from possessions or accomplishments, but the deep peace that fills our hearts when we put Him first. The Ten Commandments are not restrictions meant to limit us; rather, they are a roadmap for living joyfully, lovingly, and in harmony with God’s will. When we place our own wants above all else or chase after “more” in the world, we often find ourselves drained and dissatisfied. But when we open our hearts to Him, allowing His light to guide our choices, we discover the freedom and fulfillment we were created for. 


**Family of the Month:
