Reflections on Giving

“Therefore, every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire.”
 – Matthew 3:10

As we continue our Advent journey, today’s Gospel invites us to take an honest look at the fruit our lives are bearing. Do we spend our time in prayer, or do we allow it to slip away in distraction? Do we use our talents to support and uplift others, or do our busy schedules leave little room to serve? Do we share our financial blessings with the Church, or do we accumulate more things that ultimately go unused?

Our time, talent, and treasure are gifts from God. What we choose to do with these gifts becomes our offering back to Him. As we prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ this Christmas, Advent is the perfect moment to reflect: What gifts am I planning to give to the Lord this season—gifts that bear good and lasting fruit?

This spirit of stewardship is also at the heart of our capital campaign, *His Church. Our Faith. Our Time.* To date, we have received **\$2,031,717.11 in pledges from 239 donors**, representing **9.1% participation**. Because of this generosity, we are moving forward with the much-needed parking lot expansion—a significant first step toward our long-term campus vision. Yet additional funding will be required to complete the next phases, including the parish offices and meeting spaces that will support our growing community.

As you consider your Advent and Christmas giving, please prayerfully think about making a sacrificial gift to His Church. Our Faith. Our Time. Together, through faithful stewardship, we can bear abundant fruit for Christ and build a stronger parish home for generations to come.


