Stewardship Corner

“You too must be patient. Make your hearts firm, because the coming of the Lord is at hand.”
- JAMES 5:8

Patience is something many of us struggle with. We want things to unfold according to our plan and our timing. Any change can stir up anxiety or fear. Yet through daily prayer, God gently reveals His will and shows us how to use our gifts in ways far better than anything we could design ourselves. Advent invites us to slow down, to listen, and to align our hearts with God’s plan.

If all the decorations and shopping were stripped away, how would others know that we are Christians preparing for the birth of Jesus? When John the Baptist asked if Jesus was truly the Messiah, Jesus pointed to His actions - healing, restoring, lifting up the poor. The same is true for us. Our witness is made known not by our words but by what we do for the vulnerable and the suffering. This week, reflect on this question: **If someone observed your family from the outside, what actions would they see that show you are Catholic Christians preparing for Christ’s coming?** How might you bring healing, hope, and “good news” to others, especially migrants, refugees, and those in need?

Your generosity continues to reveal Christ’s presence. In November, our parish donated **2,286 lbs of food** to the **Little Elm Area Food Bank**, **5,434 lbs of food** to the **Neighbors Nourishing Neighbors Food Pantry**, and **\$1,500** in monetary assistance. And this Advent, you have already taken **138 Giving Tree tags** to support the **Children’s Advocacy Center**. Throughout December, we invite you to continue supporting their work with needed items for therapy sessions, Rainbow Room supplies, or through a monetary gift.

Together, may we prepare the way of the Lord by being evidence of God’s radical hope through our actions of compassion, hospitality, and love.


Mission Statement

It is hard to believe that we are finishing with our first semester already! These past few months have just flown by for our St. Martin de Porres Catholic School students, teachers, and staff.

With the start of the new year, we begin to look at new enrollment for the 2026-2027 academic year. Each year, we give our current families a chance to enroll younger siblings during the month of January, prior to opening enrollment to the general public in February. This year, we would also like to extend this early enrollment opportunity to St. Martin de Porres parishioners. So, starting on January 1, 2026, parishioners, who are officially registered with the parish (minimum one year), can enroll a PK3 year-old, PK4 year-old, or Kindergarten-aged child for the 2026-2027 school year using our standard application process. These sections always fill up fast and have weight lists, so we wanted to give our parishioners a head start like we do current families.

If you would like to have a personal tour of the school, please call the school office to set up a day and time, and we would be happy to accommodate you. 


