## Stewardship Corner

***“When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took his wife into his home.” — Matthew 1:24***

Joseph’s quiet obedience is a powerful witness for us as we enter these final days of Advent. He trusted completely in the Lord without knowing how everything would unfold or what it would cost him. He placed God first, followed where God led, and expected nothing in return. In this way, Joseph stands as a model of discipleship and stewardship—rooted in faith, humility, and courageous trust.

When something unexpected happens, how do we respond? Mary did not expect to become the mother of Jesus, and Joseph did not expect that his bride would be miraculously pregnant. Either could have said no. Joseph could have walked away. Instead, both Mary and Joseph said “yes” to God, even when they did not fully understand His plan. Their yes changed the world.

As Christmas draws near, we may find that our own plans do not unfold exactly as we hoped. Yet, like Mary and Joseph, good things can still happen when we say “yes” to God—yes to trust, yes to generosity, yes to serving where we are needed.

As part of your Advent preparation, we invite you to prayerfully reflect on your stewardship of the gifts God has entrusted to you. Are you using your time, talent, and treasure in ways that reflect your trust in Him? Is your giving aligned with the gratitude in your heart?

*Lord, thank You for the blessings You’ve given me and the ways You provide. Help me to use these gifts wisely and share them with a joyful heart. This Advent, open my eyes to see where I’m needed, and let my giving reflect Your love. Amen.*



It is hard to believe that we are finishing with our first semester already! These past few months have just flown by for our St. Martin de Porres Catholic School students, teachers, and staff.

With the start of the new year, we begin to look at new enrollment for the 2026-2027 academic year. Each year, we give our current families a chance to enroll younger siblings during the month of January, prior to opening enrollment to the general public in February. This year, we would also like to extend this early enrollment opportunity to St. Martin de Porres parishioners. So, starting on January 1, 2026, parishioners, who are officially registered with the parish (minimum one year), can enroll a PK3 year-old, PK4 year-old, or Kindergarten-aged child for the 2026-2027 school year using our standard application process. 
