## Stewardship Corner

**“John tried to prevent him, saying, ‘I need to be baptized by you, yet you are coming to me?’”**  
- Matthew 3:14

At the Baptism of the Lord, we witness a moment of profound humility. Jesus, who is without sin, steps into the waters of the Jordan and submits Himself to John’s baptism. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that Jesus’ immersion in water is a sign for all humanity of the need to die to self in order to do God’s will. In this simple yet powerful act, Jesus shows us the posture of true discipleship: surrender.

For us as baptized Catholics, this moment invites an important question: *What do we give to Jesus in return?* Ultimately, there is only one gift He asks of us - the gift of ourselves. When we surrender our lives to God, trusting Him fully, we allow the Holy Spirit to work through us for His greater glory. This surrender is not limited to prayer or worship alone; it touches every part of our lives, including how we view and use our money and possessions.

Recent studies reveal a significant “Catholic giving gap” in the United States. Many Catholics rarely engage in voluntary financial giving, not because of a lack of generosity of heart, but because money is often compartmentalized - separated from faith and spiritual life. Yet the research also shows something hopeful: Catholics who see their money as belonging ultimately to God, and who engage with it as a spiritual matter, are far more generous.

Generosity flourishes when giving is connected to mission and vision, not merely to “paying the bills.” When we understand our financial stewardship as a response to God’s grace - an extension of our baptismal call - we begin to see our gifts as instruments of transformation for ourselves, our parish, and the world.

As we reflect on the Baptism of the Lord, may we renew our own baptismal promises by offering not just part of our lives, but *all* of ourselves to God - our time, our talents, and our treasure - trusting that He will use them to build His Kingdom.


