

Stewardship Corner

“Now the Lord has spoken who formed me as his servant from the womb...” - Isaiah 49:5

From the very beginning, God has known us, formed us, and entrusted each of us with a unique purpose. He has given every person different gifts, talents, and circumstances—not by accident, but by design. For God’s plan to unfold, each of us must faithfully do what God is calling us to do. No two callings are the same, and that is exactly how the Body of Christ is meant to function.

Discerning how best to use the gifts God has given us begins with prayer. Through prayer, we open our hearts to listen to God’s voice and ask Him where and how He wants us to serve. When we take time to pray and reflect, God reveals how our gifts can be used not for our own glory, but for the good of others and the building up of His Church.

Because of this, stewardship is not about comparison. When we measure ourselves against others, envy and jealousy can quietly take root and distract us from our own mission. Instead, we are invited to be grateful for the gifts we have been given and to use them generously. Our call is not to be someone else, but to become the saint God is calling us to be.

Stewardship, then, is truly a way of life. It is the daily decision to offer our time, talent, and treasure back to God in thanksgiving for all He has given us. Through prayerful discernment and faithful action, we place our trust in God’s plan and allow Him to work through us for His greater glory.
