

## Stewardship Corner

***“He called them, and immediately they left their boat and their father and followed Him.” - Matthew 4:22***

Just as Jesus called the first apostles, He continues to call each of us today. Not everyone is asked to leave behind their family or livelihood, but all of us are called to put God first in everything. True discipleship begins with trust and gratitude - recognizing that all we have and all we are comes from God.

In gratitude, we are invited to give God our first and best:

- **Our time**, through daily prayer and attentiveness to God’s voice.
- **Our talent**, by participating in parish ministries and serving others.
- **Our treasure**, by supporting the mission and needs of our parish and those in need.

Pride and ego are often at the root of our struggles. When we begin to think our time is too valuable, our talents too important, or our money a source of status, we risk placing those things before God. Yet everything we possess is a gift freely given by Him. Gratitude naturally leads us to humility - an honest awareness that we depend entirely on God’s generosity.

Stewardship is sometimes misunderstood as being only about money, but it is far more than that. To be a good steward is to care responsibly for all the gifts God has entrusted to us. The first and most fundamental of those gifts is life itself. You are alive today - that alone is a gift. How will you use it?

We are called to love God by serving one another. Our work, our responsibilities, and even our daily routines are not merely ways to get by or get ahead; they are opportunities to serve and to glorify God through our actions.

This week, as we continue into the new year, take time to reflect on how to “kick-start” or renew your faith. Some may already feel steady and strong - if so, may this reflection encourage you to persevere. Others may feel weary, discouraged, or in need of a fresh start. Let this be an invitation to begin again.

Perhaps the best way to live the Christian life is to focus on being a good steward of today. As Psalm 118:24 reminds us: *“This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.”*

Reflect on the gifts God has given you with gratitude rather than regret, and with purpose rather than comparison. Ask yourself how you can use those gifts - today - for the benefit of others and for the glory of God.



## Jan 31/Feb 1 Candlemas

The Annual Blessing of the Candles  
and  
The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

Every year on February 2, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord and the Blessing of the Candles, also known as Candlemas.

Forty days after His birth, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Temple in obedience to the Law of Moses, offering the sacrifice of the poor—two turtledoves (Luke 2:24). In this moment, Christ is proclaimed as the Light of the world, coming to dispel sin and darkness.

For this reason, candles are blessed at Mass on this feast and used throughout the year, a tradition that gives us the name *Candlemas*.

**Candlemas will be celebrated at all Masses the weekend of January 31-February 1.**

You are invited to bring your own candles (unscented, preferably white or ivory) to be blessed for use throughout the year. The blessing of candles will take place at the beginning of each Mass in the Narthex.


