Candlemas

The Annual Blessing of the Candles
and
The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

Every year on February 2, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord and the Blessing of the Candles, also known as Candlemas.

Forty days after His birth, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Temple in obedience to the Law of Moses, offering the sacrifice of the poor—two turtledoves (Luke 2:24). In this moment, Christ is proclaimed as the Light of the world, coming to dispel sin and darkness.

For this reason, candles are blessed at Mass on this feast and used throughout the year, a tradition that gives us the name *Candlemas*.

Candlemas will be celebrated at all Masses the weekend of January 31-February 1.
You are invited to bring your own candles (unscented, preferably white or ivory) to be blessed for use throughout the year. The blessing of candles will take place at the beginning of each Mass in the Narthex.



Stewardship Corner

“Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.” - Matthew 5:3

The phrase “poor in spirit” may seem puzzling at first, but Jesus is not praising weakness or lack of worth. Rather, He calls us to trust—to recognize our complete dependence on God rather than on our own self-reliance. To be poor in spirit is to loosen our hold on earthly comforts like power and wealth, and to cling more fully to heavenly values such as charity, mercy, sacrifice, and love.

Living this way asks something real of us. It means putting the needs of others before our own and sharing what we have so all may live with dignity. Being poor in spirit is not about having less, but about trusting God enough to live with open hands.

Because of last week’s inclement weather and the cancellation of all Masses, many may not have had the opportunity to reflect on last week’s Stewardship Corner. The message, however, beautifully prepares us for today’s Gospel and is worth revisiting.

Last week we reflected on Jesus calling the first apostles, who immediately left everything to follow Him (Matthew 4:22). While most of us are not asked to leave our livelihood or family, we are all called to place God first. True discipleship begins with trust and gratitude, recognizing that all we have and all we are come from God.

From this gratitude flows **stewardship**: offering God our **time** in prayer, our **talent** in service, and our **treasure** in generous support of the Church and those in need. When pride leads us to value our gifts above the Giver, we lose sight of their true purpose. Everything we possess is a gift freely given by God.

Stewardship is often misunderstood as being only about money, but it is far richer than that. To be a good steward is to care for all that God has entrusted to us—beginning with the gift of life itself. Simply being alive today is a gift.

As we move forward into the year and begin preparing our hearts for the season of Lent, take a moment to reflect on where you are right now. Some may feel steady and strong in faith; others may feel weary or in need of a fresh start. Wherever you find yourself, let today be an invitation to begin again—trusting God more fully, comparing yourself less, and living with gratitude.

“This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.” (Psalm 118:24). Be a good steward of today. Ask yourself how you can use the gifts God has given you—not someday, not when it’s easier, but now—for the good of others and for the glory of God.






