Parish Financial Update – Second Quarter (as of December 31, 2025)

As of December 31, 2025, total parish revenue year-to-date is **\$989,694**, an increase of 7.3% over the same period last year. This progress reflects the shared stewardship of our parish family and continued engagement in parish life.

Offertory contributions total **\$688,736**, an increase of 1.9% compared to the prior year. During the same period, Mass attendance for FY26 increased by **14.4%** year over year, inviting reflection on how our stewardship of treasure accompanies our participation in parish life.

Contributions and grants totaled **\$240,402**, up \$53,078 from last year, including \$35,776.65 designated for debt reduction and \$11,500 contributed to the Fr. James Cuneo Memorial Endowment. While these gifts strengthen the long-term financial health of the parish, offertory remains the primary support for daily operations and ministries.

Expenses continue to be monitored carefully as the parish balances limited financial resources with the growing needs of our ministries and parish community.

Stewardship is a way of life rooted in gratitude. “As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another.” (1 Peter 4:10) Through the sharing of time, talent, and treasure, we each play a role in sustaining the mission of St. Martin de Porres.
