# Financial Notes

**Parish Financial Update – Second Quarter (as of December 31, 2025)**

As of December 31, 2025, total parish revenue year-to-date is **\$989,694, an increase of 7.3%** over the same period last year. We are grateful for this growth and for the continued engagement of our parish family.

Offertory contributions total **\$688,736, reflecting an increase of only 1.9%** compared to the prior year. During that same period, **Mass attendance for FY26 increased by 14.4%**. This significant growth in participation is a blessing — but it also highlights **a widening gap between attendance and offertory support**. As our parish community grows, so do the financial demands required to sustain our liturgies, ministries, staff, and facilities.

Contributions and grants totaled **\$240,402, up \$53,078 from last year**, including **\$35,776.65 designated for debt reduction** and **\$11,500 contributed to the Fr. James Cuneo Memorial Endowment**. These designated gifts are vital for our long-term financial stability; however, **they cannot be used for daily operating expenses**. The offertory remains **the primary and essential source of funding** for the parish’s ongoing mission and ministries.
