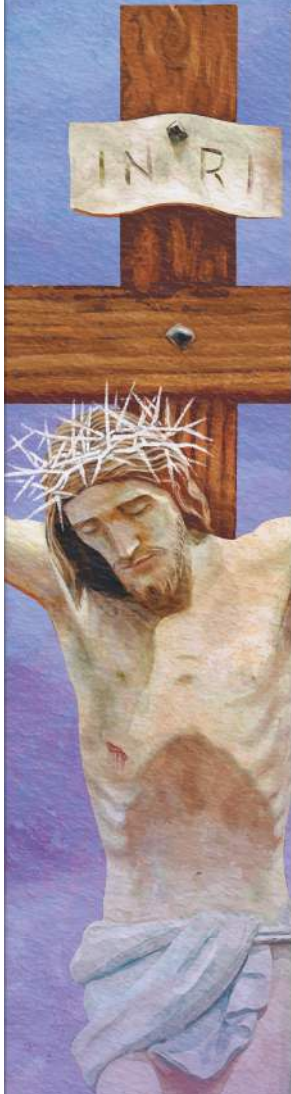

Stewardship Corner

“It is written: ‘The Lord, your God, shall you worship and Him alone shall you serve.’” — Matthew 4:10

When Jesus was tempted with the riches and power of this world, He chose instead faithful service to His Father. Lent invites us to make that same choice — to turn away from whatever competes with God in our lives and to place Him again at the center. It is a sacred season to repent, to let go of the lesser “gods” we may have put first, and to nurture what leads us closer to heaven.

As we enter this Lenten journey, it is also a fitting time to reflect on our shared responsibility for the life of our parish. In our **Second Quarter (Q2) financial update**, we shared that offertory contributions total **\$688,736**, an increase of **1.9%** over the prior year. During that same period, **Mass attendance increased by 14.4%**. This growth in participation is a true blessing — yet it also highlights a widening gap between attendance and offertory support.

As our parish family grows, so do the resources needed to sustain our liturgies, ministries, staff, and facilities. While expenses are monitored carefully and managed responsibly, the reality is that offertory growth is not yet keeping pace with the needs of our expanding parish life.

Stewardship is more than a concept — it is a way of life rooted in gratitude and responsibility. “As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another.” (1 Peter 4:10) Each of us shares in supporting the mission of St. Martin de Porres through the faithful offering of our **time, talent, and treasure**.

Lent is traditionally a time of **prayer, fasting, and almsgiving**. As we embrace Lenten sacrifice, we might also consider how our sacrifices can bless others — whether by giving more of our time in service, sharing our talents in ministry, or offering a sacrificial gift to support the parish that nourishes our faith.

This Lent, I prayerfully invite you to reflect on your own stewardship. If you are not currently giving, or if it has been some time since you reviewed your offertory commitment, please consider doing so now. Even a modest increase, offered prayerfully and consistently, multiplied across our parish family, would make a meaningful difference.

May this holy season draw each of us closer to the Lord and to one another, and may God bless you for the many ways you already serve and support our parish family.

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.


