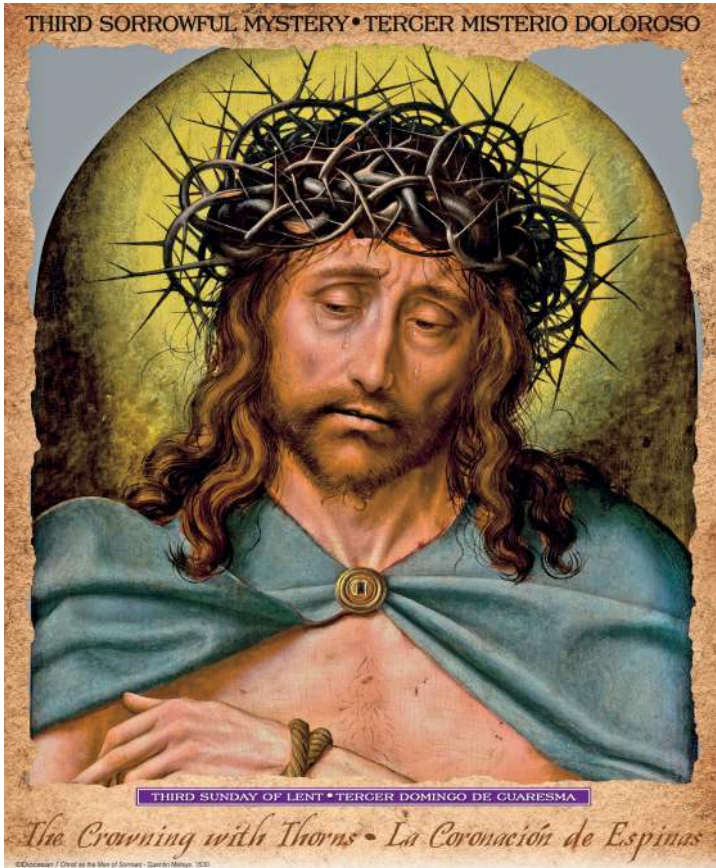

Stewardship Corner

Stewardship Begins with Gratitude

“Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again.” — John 4:13

In today’s Gospel, Jesus meets the Samaritan woman at the well and speaks about a deeper kind of thirst — the longing in every human heart that cannot be satisfied by earthly things. As Jesus reminds us, even something as basic as water will leave us thirsty again.

The same can be true of the many things we pursue in life. When we build our lives around material possessions, achievements, or personal desires, we often find ourselves wanting more. No matter how much we gain, something still feels incomplete. These things can bring temporary satisfaction, but they cannot fill the deeper longing of the human heart.

Jesus offers something greater. He speaks of “living water,” the life that comes from knowing and following Him. True joy and lasting peace come when we allow Christ to be at the center of our lives — when we become more **God-centered** and less **self-centered**. Stewardship begins with gratitude. Before we offer anything to God, we remember that **He has already given everything to us first** — our life, our faith, our blessings, and His Son. When we recognize these gifts with thankful hearts, our priorities begin to shift. We begin to see that the deepest fulfillment in life does not come from what we possess, but from our relationship with God.

Lent invites us to reflect on what truly satisfies the thirst of our hearts. When we spend time with the Lord in prayer, in Scripture, and in the sacraments, we encounter the “living water” Christ promises — a life rooted not in what we own, but in the love and grace of God.

What might you need to let go of so that Christ can more fully satisfy the thirst of your heart this Lent?

“Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His mercy endures forever.” — Psalm 107:1



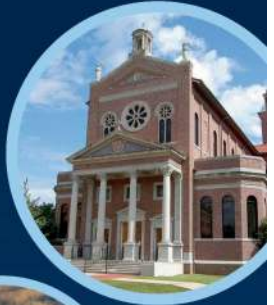

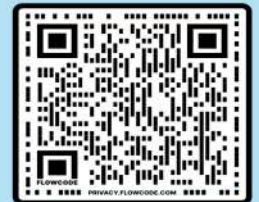
