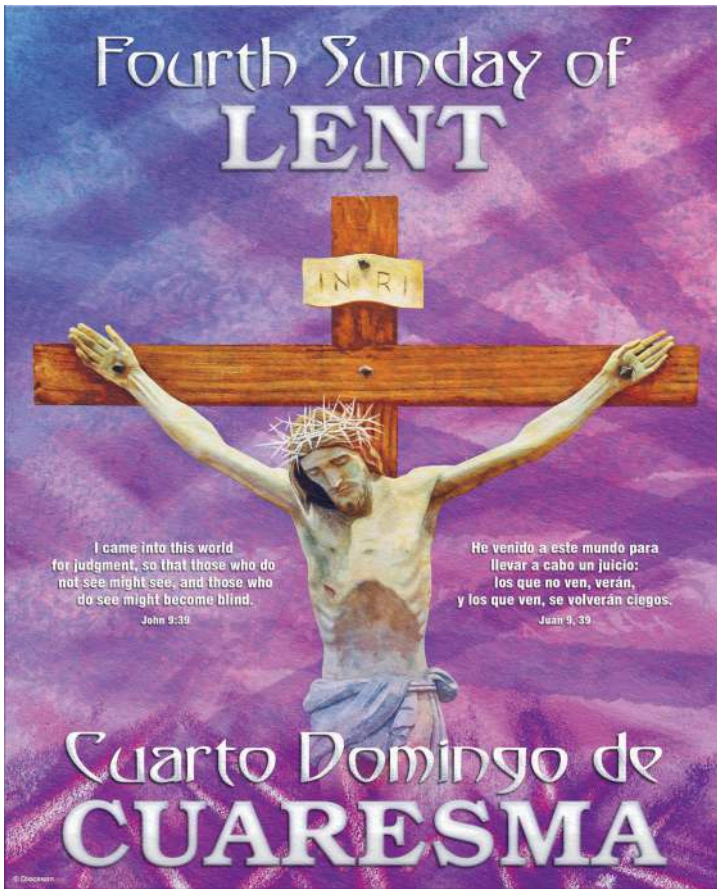

Stewardship Corner

Stewardship Begins with Gratitude

“Not as man sees does God see, because man sees the appearance, but the Lord looks into the heart.”

- 1 Samuel 16:7

In today’s readings, we are reminded that God sees far more deeply than we do. While people often judge by outward appearances, the Lord looks into the heart. We spend much of our lives concerned with how things appear to others - the success we achieve, the possessions we accumulate, the image we present to the world. Yet none of these outward signs define who we truly are before God.

In the Gospel, Jesus heals a man who had been blind from birth. After encountering Christ, the man is able not only to see physically but also to recognize who Jesus truly is. Those around him struggle to believe what has happened because they are focused on appearances and expectations. The man, however, speaks a simple truth born from experience: “I was blind and now I see.”

This moment reminds us that faith allows us to see our lives differently. When Christ opens our eyes, we begin to recognize the deeper reality of God’s presence and the many blessings He has given us. We start to understand that what matters most is not what we possess or how we appear to others, but the condition of our hearts.

Stewardship begins with gratitude. Before we offer anything to God, we remember that **He has already given everything to us first** - our life, our faith, our gifts, and His Son. When we truly see these blessings, our hearts begin to change. Gratitude helps us recognize that our time, our talents, and our resources are not simply our own achievements, but gifts entrusted to us by a loving God.

Lent invites us to allow Christ to open our eyes so that we may see more clearly. When we begin to see as God sees, our priorities shift. Instead of striving for appearances, we focus on living with faith, generosity, and love for God and neighbor.

Where might God be inviting you to see more clearly and to offer your time, talent, and treasure from a grateful heart this Lent?

“Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His mercy endures forever.” — Psalm 107:1



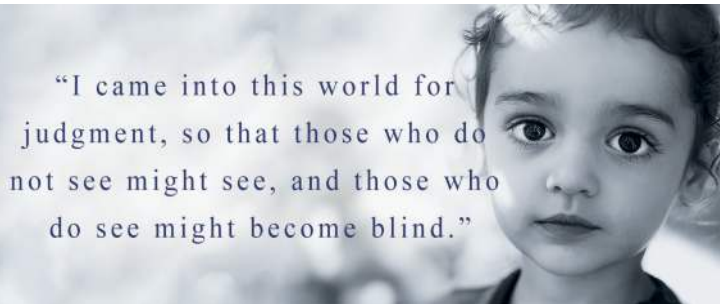
