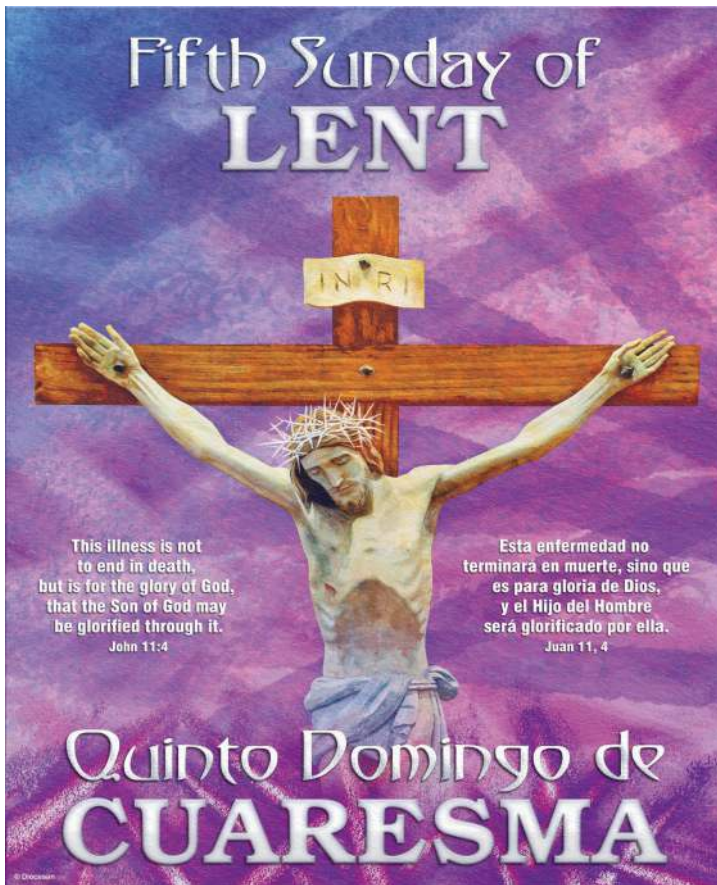

## Stewardship Corner

### Stewardship Begins with Gratitude

*“Jesus said to her, ‘Did I not tell you that if you believe you will see the glory of God?’” — John 11:40*

In today’s Gospel, Jesus speaks these words just before raising Lazarus from the dead. Martha is grieving and struggling to understand what is happening, yet Jesus invites her to trust beyond what she can see. His words remind us that faith is not only about what we profess, but about the trust we place in God even in the most difficult moments of our lives.

Many of us say that we believe in God. We attend Sunday Mass, participate in parish life, and try to live according to our faith. But when life becomes challenging — when circumstances are uncertain or things are not going as we had hoped — do we truly trust in the Lord? Do we believe that God is still present and working in our lives?

**In moments like these, gratitude becomes the bridge between what we cannot see and the trust we are called to have, helping us recognize how God has already been at work in our lives.**

Stewardship begins with gratitude. When we live with grateful hearts, recognizing all that God has already given us, we begin to see His presence more clearly. Gratitude reminds us that God has always been faithful, providing for us in ways both great and small. A grateful and generous life opens our eyes to the ways God continues to work in the world. As we place our trust in Him, we begin to see the “glory of God” revealed in our daily lives — in moments of grace, in acts of kindness, and in the blessings we share with others. Through this life of faith and gratitude, we truly become what Scripture calls “partakers of the divine nature.”

As Lent draws us closer to Holy Week, we are invited to deepen our trust in God and to recognize the many gifts He has placed in our lives.

**Where might God be inviting you to trust Him more fully and live more generously with the gifts He has given you?**

*“Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His mercy endures forever.” — Psalm 107:1*

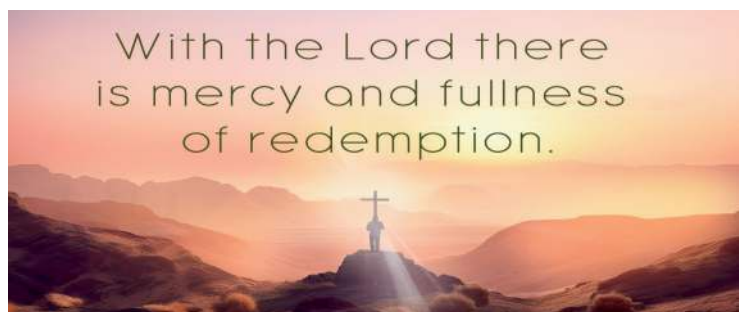
