Stewardship Corner

Stewardship Begins with Gratitude

"As they were marching out, they came upon a man of Cyrene, Simon by name; this man they pressed into service to carry His cross." - Matthew 27:32

Today we begin Holy Week as we remember Jesus' entry into Jerusalem and listen to the story of His Passion. In the midst of this powerful Gospel, we encounter a brief but meaningful moment: Simon of Cyrene is called upon to help carry the cross of Christ.

Simon likely did not expect to become part of this moment. Yet his willingness to carry the cross reminds us that God often calls us in ordinary circumstances to share in the burdens of others.

The Lord calls us to love God and to love our neighbor. Every day we are presented with opportunities to love our neighbor and help him "carry his cross." These opportunities are rarely big or dramatic. More often, they are simple, everyday moments — helping someone carry their groceries, holding the door open, offering encouragement, or taking the time to listen.

It is often in serving others — in these ordinary moments of love — that our hearts begin to recognize the extraordinary gifts we have received.

Stewardship begins with gratitude. When we recognize how much God has given us, our hearts become more attentive to the needs of others. Gratitude moves us beyond ourselves and invites us to serve with generosity, placing the needs of others before our own without expecting anything in return.

As we enter this sacred week, we are reminded that love is most clearly revealed in the way we give ourselves for others.

Where might God be inviting you to help someone carry their cross this week?

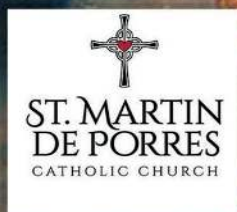

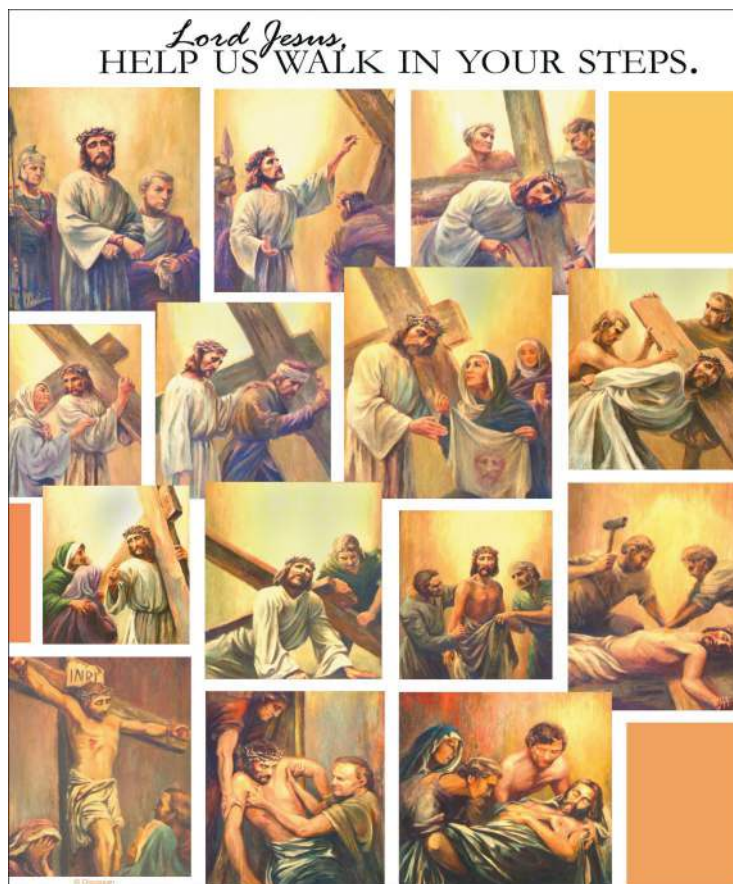

HOW TO MAKE A REPORT:

If you suspect abuse or neglect of a child, elder or vulnerable adult*, or if abuse has been disclosed to you:

1. Call CPS (800-252-5400); get a case number or copy of report.

AND /OR

Call the Police or 911; get a case number or copy of report.

AND

2. Immediately report the alleged abuse to your supervisor, Priest or Principal and submit the Confidential Notice of Concern with CPS report information.

In the case of alleged abuse by clergy or Church personnel, contact the Victim Assistance Hotline, Director of Safe Environment, or Chancellor of the Diocese directly.
