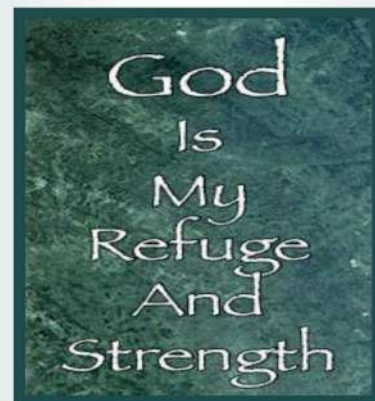

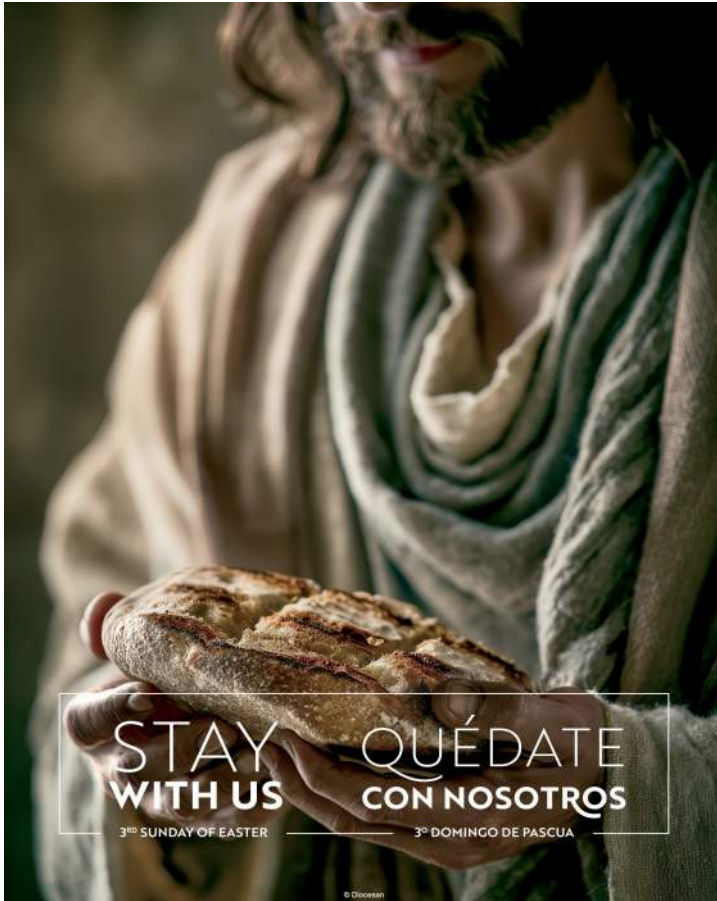

Stewardship Corner

“Did not our hearts burn within us while He talked to us on the road, while He opened to us the scriptures?” - Luke 24:32

Christ is risen! Indeed, He is risen!

In today’s Gospel, the disciples on the road to Emmaus encounter the risen Lord, though at first they do not recognize Him. As Jesus walks with them and opens the Scriptures, something begins to stir within them. Later, they reflect on that moment and say, “Did not our hearts burn within us?” It is only in hindsight that they realize Christ had been with them all along.

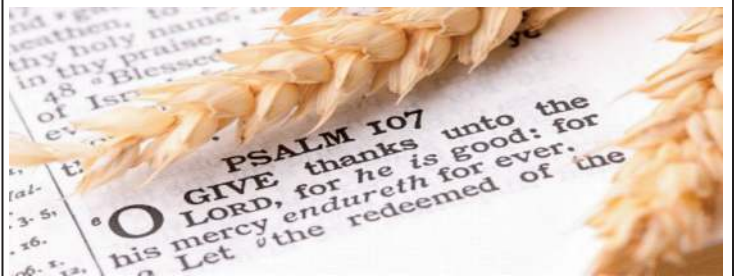
Their experience reminds us that faith is not simply about knowledge, but about relationship. How often do we take time to truly listen for what Jesus is asking of us? Are our prayers only petitions, or do we also allow space for Him to speak? Like any relationship, our life with Christ requires both speaking and listening.

As Catholic Christians, we celebrate Easter not for a single day, but for fifty days - a season of joy and renewal. This time, often called mystagogia, invites us to enter more deeply into the mystery of our faith and to reflect on what the Resurrection truly means in our lives.

For Christian stewards, this is a time to reexamine how faith in the Risen Lord shapes every aspect of our lives - how we pray, how we serve, how we use our time and resources, and how we love others. Christ is risen, and that truth changes everything, calling us to respond with our whole lives - through generosity, service, and love.

As we continue this Easter season, may we take time in silence to listen for His voice. Spend some quiet time with the Lord and be open to what He reveals - we may be surprised at how He is already at work in our lives. When we learn to recognize His voice, we are better able to follow where He leads.

He gave everything. How will you respond?

Reporting Abuse or Concern

The Church takes the matter of sexual abuse seriously and urges anyone who has been abused to talk to someone in order to heal. If you have any reasonable suspicion of abuse or exploitation of children or vulnerable adults:

1. Call Child Protective Services (CPS) at [800-252-5400](tel:800-252-5400) and follow the directions to file a report with a case worker / online report (Request a case number or a copy of the report).
2. Call the Police and ask to file a report of abuse (Request a case number or a copy of the report).
3. Report the alleged abuse to your supervisor, Priest or Principal (who will report to diocese) with copy of CPS report made or written report with contact information on all concerned, description of abuse, dates if known and how you learned of the abuse.
4. In the case of alleged abuse by clergy or Church personnel, contact a diocesan authority directly.
