He gave everything. How will you respond?

"My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." - John 10:27

"Repent, and be baptized... in the name of Jesus Christ." - Acts 2:38

Christ is risen! Indeed, He is risen!

In today's Gospel, Jesus reveals Himself as the Good Shepherd, one who knows His sheep and calls them by name. He reminds us that His followers hear His voice and follow Him. This is the heart of discipleship - a relationship built on listening, trust, and a willingness to respond.

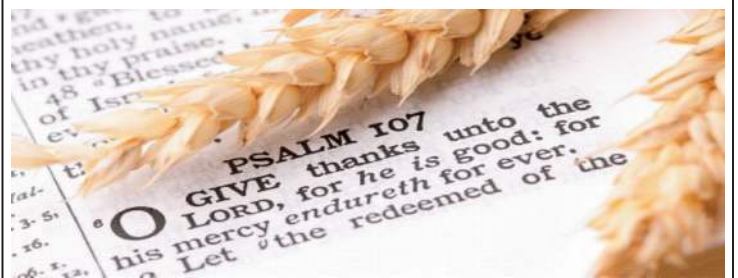
In the Acts of the Apostles, Peter proclaims a similar invitation: "Repent." This call is not simply about turning away from sin, but about a deeper conversion of heart - a transformation in how we think, speak, and live. It begins with recognizing our need for God and opening ourselves to His grace.

These two messages are closely connected. To follow the voice of the Good Shepherd, we must be willing to change. True conversion requires prayer, discipline, and perseverance. It also requires quiet moments of listening, where we allow Christ to guide us and shape our hearts.

For Christian stewards, this call to conversion touches every aspect of our lives. Stewardship is not only about what we give, but about who we are becoming. As we learn to hear His voice more clearly, we begin to follow more faithfully - in how we use our time, share our gifts, and love those around us.

He gave everything. How will you respond?



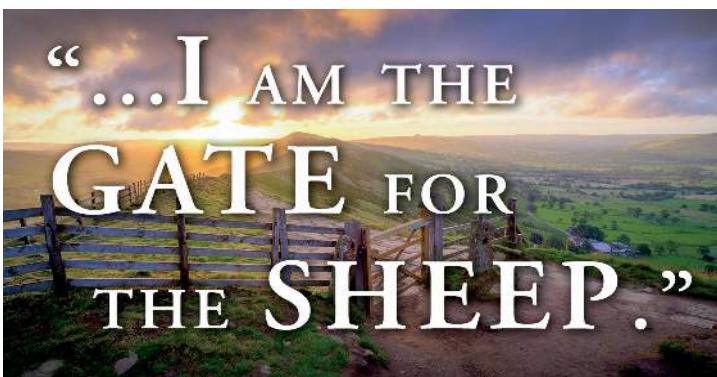

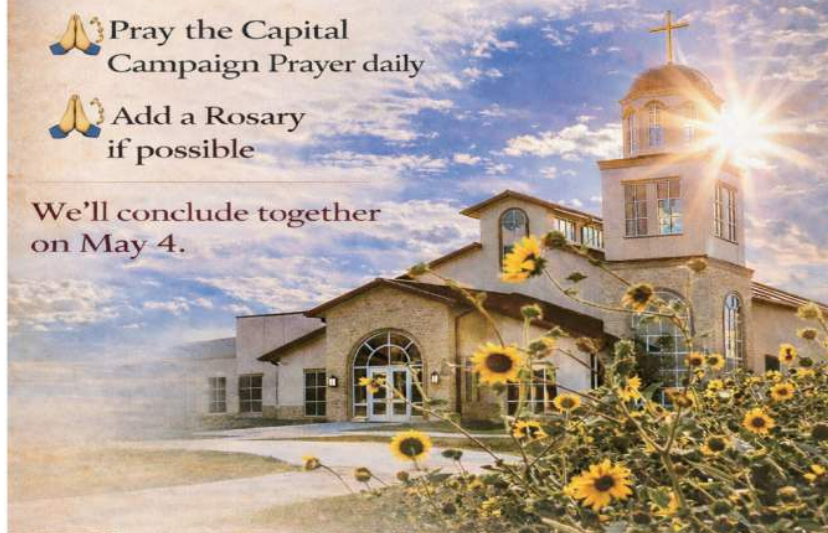

Child Abuse Prevention Month

Keeping Families Informed

Any type of abuse a child can endure has the potential to not only cause a family crisis, but also lead to personal and interpersonal issues in other avenues of life. That's why it's essential for parents to be as informed as possible.

Signs & Symptoms of Abuse

Signs and symptoms of child abuse tend to be subtle. Sometimes the child may show no physical signs at all, so it's important to note changes in behavior or routine. Below are some of the most telling signs to look for:

Listen to Your Child

- Ask your child about his or her activities. Find out who they spend their time with, and try to learn more about those people. Ask what they did at school, at the birthday party, etc.
- Listen to your child if they say they are uncomfortable around someone. Ask open-ended questions to learn more about what makes them feel that way. Lastly, let them know it's okay to speak up when they feel uncomfortable.
- Pay attention to changes in behavior or attitude.

Talk to Your Child

- Tell your child that some parts of their bodies are private, and no one is allowed to touch them there. Explain where these private parts are.
- Teach your child the correct names of their body parts. It's important to know and be comfortable with the names of their private areas and be able to talk about them openly.

Discuss Boundaries

- Let your child know it's okay for them to set their own boundaries for their body. Offering a high five instead of a hug is perfectly fine.
- Teach them to speak up against individuals who make them uncomfortable and to share their feelings of discomfort with you.
- Teach children to speak to you, or someone they trust, about times when someone violates their boundaries

Internet Safety

- Have your children use their computers, cell phones, and tablets in a centralized area of the house you should be able to monitor their usage at any given time. At bedtime, suggest that everyone charges their phone in the living room, and not in the bedroom.
- Set guidelines for online use. Post online rules on the computer or fridge where everyone can see them every day.
