He gave everything. How will you respond?

“Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations...” - Matthew 28:19

Christ is risen! Indeed, He is risen!

In today's Gospel, the risen Jesus gathers His disciples and gives them a mission: “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations.” These are not just final instructions - they are an invitation to continue His work in the world. Even in their uncertainty, the disciples are entrusted with something extraordinary.

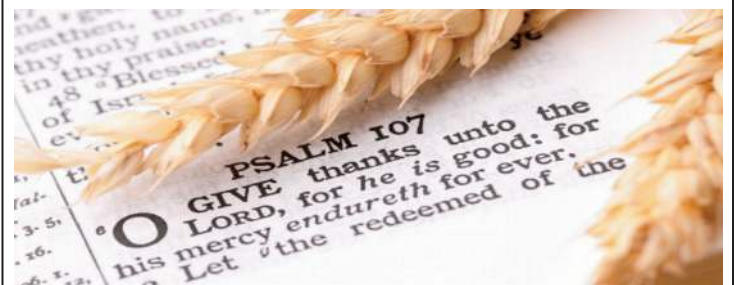
The Ascension reminds us that Christ does not leave us behind - He sends us forward. He entrusts His mission to us, calling each of us to be witnesses of His love. This can feel overwhelming at times. Like the disciples, we may feel unprepared or unsure of what lies ahead.

Yet St. Paul reminds us in Ephesians that we are not alone. God gives us “a spirit of wisdom and revelation” so that we may come to know Him more fully. Christ is not distant - He is alive and present, working through us as members of His Body.

For Christian stewards, this mission is lived in the everyday. We make disciples not only through words, but through the way we live - in how we give our time, share our gifts, and love others. Every act of generosity, every moment of service, becomes a witness to the presence of Christ.

As we prepare for Pentecost, we are invited to step forward in faith, trusting that God will guide us and strengthen us for the mission ahead.

Financial Notes

Parish Financial Update– Third Quarter (as of March 31, 2026)

We give thanks for the continued vitality of our parish community. Average weekend Mass attendance has grown from **1,895** to **2,161**, an increase of **14%** over last year.

During this same period, offertory giving has increased by **3.75%**, which has not kept pace with the growth in participation.

Through March 31, total parish revenue is **\$1,633,170**, with total expenses of **\$1,484,552**. However, approximately **\$214,271** of revenue is designated for specific purposes and not available for operations, resulting in a **year-to-date operating shortfall of \$65,653**.

Some of these designated funds have been applied toward **debt reduction**, strengthening the parish's long-term financial position.

We are grateful for the generosity and engagement of our parishioners. As our parish continues to grow, we encourage each household to prayerfully reflect on how they support the ongoing life and mission of the parish.
