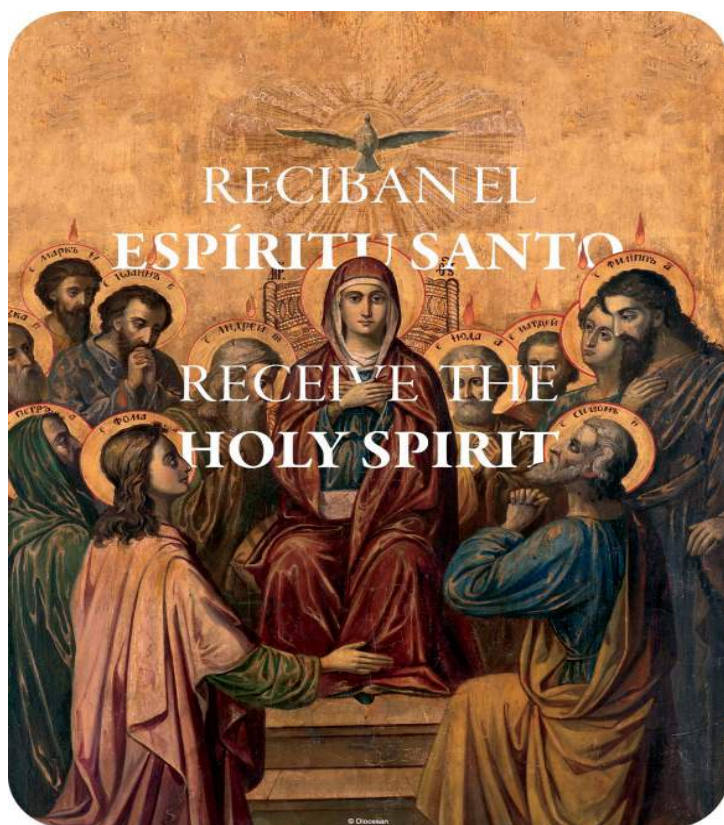

"And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit..."

- Acts 2:4

Christ is risen! Indeed, He is risen!

Today we celebrate Pentecost - the moment the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and empowered them to go forth and proclaim the Good News. What began in fear and uncertainty is transformed into boldness and mission. The same disciples who once hid behind locked doors now step forward with courage, filled with the Spirit and ready to share Christ with the world.
