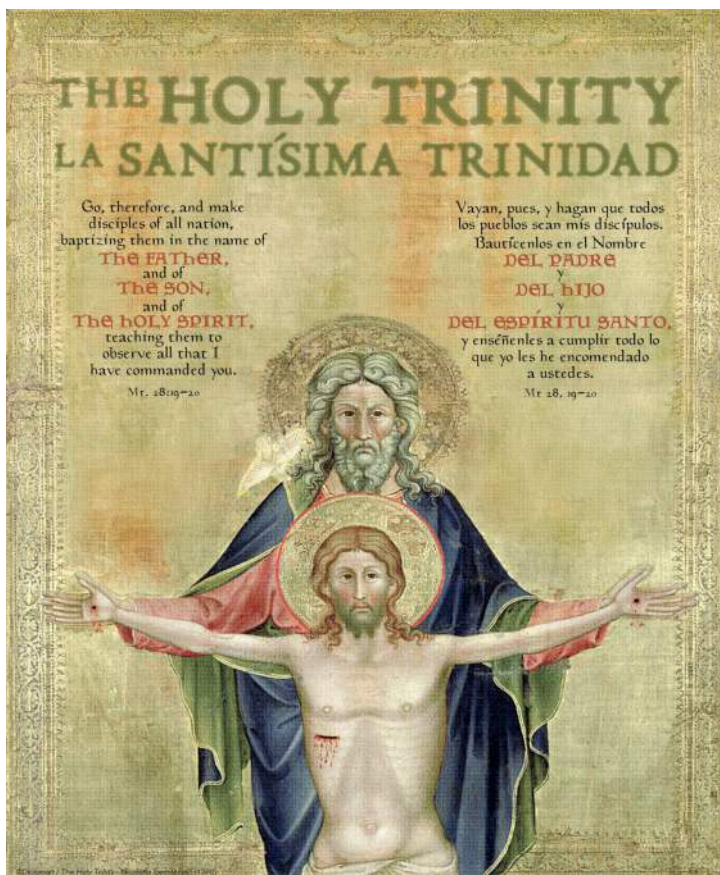

Stewardship Corner

He gave everything. How will you respond?

“For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son...” - John 3:16

Today we celebrate the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. While the Trinity is a mystery beyond our complete understanding, today’s readings reveal something beautifully clear: our God is a God of love, communion, and self-gift.

In the Gospel, we hear one of the most familiar verses in all of Scripture: “For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son.” These words remind us that salvation begins with God’s initiative. Before we ever respond to Him, God gives first. He gives completely. The Father gives the Son, and the Holy Spirit continues to guide and sustain us in faith.

St. Paul echoes this same truth in his closing words to the Corinthians: “The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.” The Christian life is rooted in this relationship with the Triune God - receiving His grace, living in His love, and remaining united through the Holy Spirit.

For Christian stewards, gratitude is the natural response to such extraordinary love. When we recognize all that God has given us, our hearts begin to change. We become more willing to share our time, our gifts, and our resources in service to others. Stewardship is not simply about what we do, but about living as disciples shaped by the self-giving love of God.

Spend some quiet time with the Lord this week reflecting on the many ways God has worked in your life. Be attentive to where He may be calling you to grow in faith, generosity, and love.

He gave everything. How will you respond?
