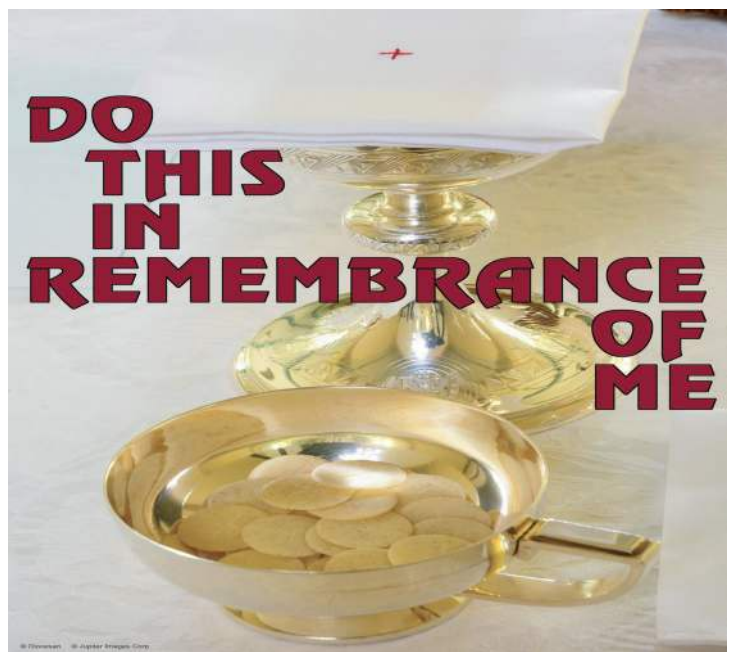

Stewardship Corner

He gave everything. How will you respond?

"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever."

- John 6:51

Today we celebrate the gift of the Eucharist - the Body and Blood of Christ freely given for the life of the world. In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that He is the living bread come down from heaven. This is not symbolic generosity or distant love. In the Eucharist, Christ gives Himself completely and remains with us, nourishing us for the journey of faith.

Throughout this stewardship journey, we have reflected on a simple truth: God gives first. Corpus Christi reveals the fullness of that gift. Jesus does not merely teach us how to love - He becomes the gift itself, offering His Body and Blood so that we may have life in Him. He gave everything.

St. Paul reminds us that though we are many, we become one body because we share in the one loaf. The Eucharist draws us into communion not only with Christ, but with one another. We are strengthened and sent to live differently - with grateful hearts, generous spirits, and a deeper awareness that all we have is gift.

For Christian stewards, the Eucharist becomes both nourishment and mission. Having received so great a gift, we are called to become gift for others - through generosity, service, compassion, and love.

Spend some quiet time with the Lord this week and reflect on the gift of His presence in the Eucharist. Be attentive to what He may be asking of you and where He is calling you to give more fully of yourself.

He gave everything. How will you respond?

News from the Principal's Desk

The 2025-2026 academic school year is officially in the books. We ended school on Friday, May 22nd with a fantastic Field Day filled with great games, contests, water slides, and ice pops. Many parents joined in on the fun while obtaining their last few service hours for the year.

The day before Field Day was our End-of-the-Year Awards Ceremony for all grades. The awards recognize excellence in achievement for the core subject areas of ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Religion. Once the students get to middle school, we add in Spanish as a graded course. We also have three very special yearly awards given out in each classroom. The Timothy Award recognizes highest overall achievement, the Marion Award recognizes service, and the Aquinas Award recognizes best effort. Even though these awards are only once a year, we do recognize students with Virtue Awards each month after our weekly School Mass and Honor (both A and A/B) Roll each grading quarter. We graduated 19 eighth graders on May 20th with some going on to JP II Catholic High School in Dallas and the others to local public high schools and charter schools.

This year was a terrific year for our school. For the first time in 14 years, we were able to host sporting events in our new gym. Girls' Volleyball and Boys/Girls' Basketball games were played during the fall and winter months. Our Archery team sent over 40 archers to the State Tournament where many had personal best scores. This upcoming school year we will be adding a new athletic sport: 6 Man Tackle Football. This sport will be for 7th and 8th grade boys. To complement this, we will also be forming a 7th and 8th grade Girls Pep Squad that will cheer on all of our sports teams.

Academically, our students continue to excel. We were well represented with 40 students participating in 75 events at the PSIA Academic District Competition with 4 of our students moving up to the State Competition in 5 events. We also had a 4th grade student take 2nd place in the Diocesan Dr. Martin Luther King Essay Contest.

This next school year will be an accreditation year for us. Catholic schools are accredited every seven years, with our last accreditation being in 2019. Our new accreditation visit will be at the end of October, so this past year the staff was very busy working on the Self-Study document. Enrollment currently is over 400 students, the largest number we have ever seen. We will have a number of new staff members, and we still have a couple of teacher openings to fill.
