We humbly ask you to pray for the future of our parish and to make an intentional, sacrificial financial commitment in support of our Phase 2 expansion.



Our Faith

The story of St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church and School is one of tremendous growth and enduring faith in the Diocese of Fort Worth. With families relocating to our area in extraordinary numbers, those seeking a spiritual home are finding it here at St. Martin de Porres.

What began as an expansion of Holy Cross Catholic Church has blossomed into a thriving faith community!

Since 2017, the number of registered parish households has tripled from 800 to 2,400. Our school now enrolls almost 400 students. Faith formation numbers are climbing steadily. More than 60 volunteer-led ministries actively carry out Christ's mission in our parish and beyond, providing countless opportunities for all of us to enrich our faith and live authentically Catholic lives in service to others.

Most joyfully, we celebrated 70 Baptisms, 96 First Communions, and 42 Confirmations in 2024, and regularly welcome more than 2,000 people - and counting - to Mass on Sundays!

Our Time

Advancing our campus master plan is critical to meet the immediate needs of our flourishing parish, anticipate future growth, and prepare the way for our future church sanctuary.

Existing parish facilities, while serving us faithfully, no longer adequately support the breadth of worship, formation, fellowship, and outreach activities at the heart of our mission.

THE TIME TO INVEST IS NOW.

Having completed Phase 1, the school expansion, we are launching a capital campaign and asking for your support to fund Phase 2, a \$10 million initiative to scale up our facilities in preparation for Phase 3, our 2,000-seat church sanctuary, rectory, and parking.

PHASE 2 PROJECTS INCLUDE:

• EXPANDED PARKING AND IMPROVED ACCESS | EST. \$1 MILLION

Eighty (80) additional parking spaces, a new access road, and efficient footpaths will dramatically improve accessibility to our current facilities, ensuring parishioners and visitors of all ages can easily attend Mass and participate in parish life.

- PARISH OFFICES, MEETING ROOMS, COMMUNAL SPACE | EST. \$4.5 MILLION

 Two (2) purpose-built facilities will provide a permanent home for parish staff and add muchneeded gathering space for faith formation, sacramental preparation, youth groups, ministry programming, and fellowship activities.
- COMMUNITY OUTREACH CENTER AND ONSITE STORAGE | EST. \$4.5 MILLION

 A permanent, shared home for equipment storage and our parish outreach department will facilitate responsible, economical stewardship of our campus while firmly grounding our parish as fount of mericiful love for those in need of material assistance and spiritual accompaniment.

The Diocese of Fort Worth requires that we secure 100% of the funding for each component of Phase 2 before construction can begin. Additionally, 10% of funds raised will be directed to the Diocese to reduce our existing debt.
