

Greetings from NOBA Foundation.

I am glad to inform you that we have started the toilet renovation work with the funds received. The old toilets have been completely demolished, and we were able to dig a new sewage tank. As per the plan, we have partitioned the sections, erected door frames, and purchased cement, bricks, and sand, which enabled us to complete the wall structures.

The remaining works include:

- Plumbing and electrical connections
- Ceilings with lights
- Wall tiling
- Floor tiling
- Installation of commodes (Western & Indian) and urinals
- Fixing doors and windows
- Common hand wash facility for both male and female

Please find attached pictures of the work completed so far. We hope to finish the remaining work at the earliest and will share the final update with more pictures and accounts once completed. Thank you once again for your kind support in making this possible.
