#### Marriage Convalidation

Are you married by the Catholic Church? No? Did you know you can have a Convalidation?

- Convalidation is the process by which Catholics who are married, but not through the Church, enter into a Valid Catholic Marriage.
- Having a Convalidation places you in good standing with the Catholic Church.
- Being in good standing means that you may go to Confession and receive Holy Communion (barring other issues).
- \* For those who are fully initiated Catholics, you may also be eligible to be God-parents.
- \* At least one of the couple needs to be a baptized Catholic. You do not need to have received all sacraments to be married, except baptism.
- Non-Catholics are not required to become Catholic.

#### **End of Year Giving**

Christmas is the season of giving. Our hearts are open to those in need around us.

As responsible givers and citizens, we know that it is also the end of the year, and charitable giving is allowable as a tax deduction. Taxpavers can deduct charitable contributions in the year they make the contributions. Therefore, contributions for 2015 must be made no later than December 31, 2015. The date of the contribution is the date that the taxpayer mails or physically hands the check to the charitable organization, so if you are planning a gift for this year, it's not too late.

In January, St. Michael's Financial Office will be providing documentation for your giving that meets IRS requirements.

Taxpavers also must select to itemize their income tax deductions using Schedule A of Form 1040 in order to claim charitable deductions. Each taxpayer should determine whether using itemized deductions or the standard deduction provides them the best tax benefit.

Cash donations are also accepted. While the level of giving has stayed the same, requests for assistance have increased tremendously, so please, be generous when you can. Thank you and May God bless you.




