# Marriage Convalidation

Are you married by the Catholic Church? No? Did you know you can have a Convalidation?

- \* Convalidation is the process by which Catholics who are married, but not through the Church, enter into a Valid Catholic Marriage.
- Having a Convalidation places you in good standing with the Catholic Church.
- Being in good standing means that you may go to Confession and receive Holy Communion (barring other issues).
- \* For those who are fully initiated Catholics, you may also be eligible to be God-parents.
- \* At least one of the couple needs to be a baptized Catholic. You do not need to have received all sacraments to be married, except baptism.
- \* Non-Catholics are not required to become Catholic.


