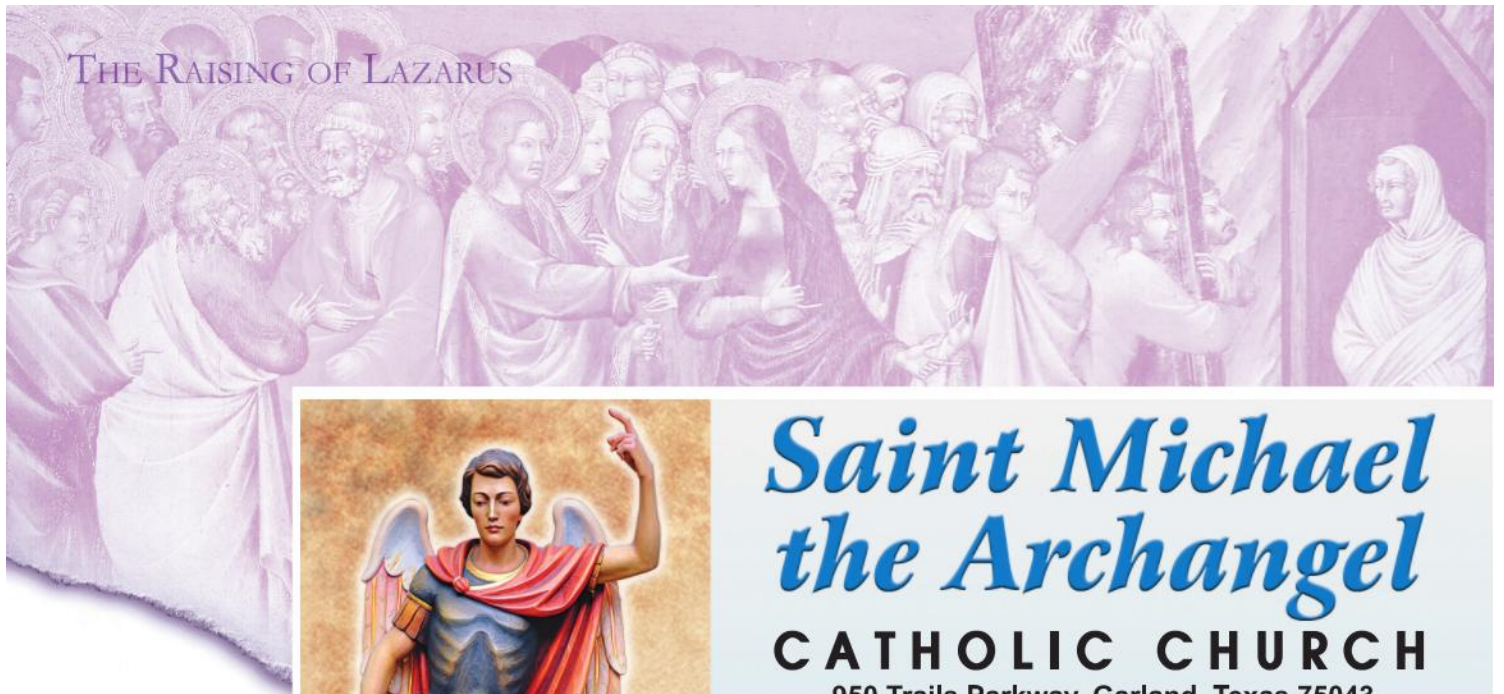

Because our Purificators are used to wipe the Precious Blood from the Chalice in preparation for the next recipient, we are also wiping lipstick and other lip products onto the Purificator.

Liturgical Linens must be laundered according to a set protocol. First they are soaked overnight, then spot cleaned, then washed. The only substance that removes the lipstick stains is putting holes in the linen. *We are asking that if you have used any lip product, please blot your lips before receiving from the Chalice.*
