

Liturgical Linens must be laundered according to a set protocol. First they are soaked overnight, then spot cleaned, then washed. The only substance that removes the lipstick stains is putting holes in the linen. We are asking that if you have used any lip product, please blot your lips before receiving from the Chalice.
